Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at Faith Lutheran Church,

While I was in the hospital and recovering from vertigo at the end of March and beginning of April, I spent time thinking about hospitality. Typically, when we think about hospitality, we think in terms of having people in our homes or even the hotel and food industry designed to serve guests that come through their doors. While this is a part of hospitality, the concept of hospitality is anchored in the care of individuals in need. This is why, when you are sick, you go to a hospital; it is the place where care is given to individuals in need. The goal of the hospital's hospitality is to care for the sick to make them well and ease the burden of their suffering. While I was in the hospital, that is certainly what I experienced. Nurses, CNAs, transport workers, doctors, food service employees and countless others that were in and out of my room, providing care, providing hospitality to one who was suffering.

But I also experienced hospitality from you. Watching you rally to send cards, drop off food, offer Erica and my family help, sending gift cards, welcome the guest pastors who were filling in my place were all incredible acts of hospitality, caring for one who was suffering in their time of need. For this, I am incredibly grateful.

Historically, hospitality is a mark of the Christian church. It was the church that founded hospitals, cared for the poor, assisted the weak, and protected the widows and orphans. This is why congregations engage in mission projects as a part of their evangelism work; it is imbedded in our culture to care for those God has placed around us because it is the reflection of his hospitality toward us. He saw us in need, suffering from our sin, so he sent his son to earn our forgiveness. He saw our bodies, stained by sin, so he washed us in the waters of baptism. He sees our faith, starving for spiritual food so he welcomes us to his table to give us the body and blood of his son so that we can have eternal life. God shows his love to us through hospitality. In return we show his love to others through our own hospitable work.

One of the heartbreaking parts of my recovery (other than not being with you to proclaim God's Word) was watching the number of people drive, jog, or walk their dog past my house on Sunday morning. I was saddened by the number of people choosing to be somewhere other than in a community of believers receiving the care that God was offering his people. They were missing the greatest hospitality, the greatest care that could ever be given, and I wondered how many even realized what they were giving up. During that time, I couldn't but pray that one day, they too, would experience the hospitality of our Lord.

Along with these thoughts, there are two other items I would like to draw to your attention. First, be sure to read the announcement regarding the special Voters' Meeting on May 31. While there will be a couple of items on the agenda, the most significant will be a conversation regarding our preschool and its future. More information can be found elsewhere in this newsletter.

Second, for the last several years our congregation has been blessed by your generosity and has ended each year with a small budget surplus. Thanks to the good stewardship of our Church Council, this money has been saved for a time when finances become tight. We have now reached that time. This year, our anticipated offerings have fallen short of our budgeted needs every month. As a result, as of the writing of this letter, we are about \$20,000 behind in giving. Thankfully, we have plenty of time to make up this deficit and because of the previous years' surpluses, we have the savings to continue to pay all our bills and meet our obligations. It is out of fairness to you and in full transparency that we are making this trend known now and not waiting until we are in a bad situation before making you aware of the problem.

This is a challenge that can follow a several year trend of abundance. When it seems like there is not a pressing need for support, gifts can be directed elsewhere, and members can become lax in maintaining their tithe and support for the congregation. If this has happened, please take the time to evaluate the support you have been giving the congregation and consider how you might be able to help make sure that Faith continues to care for all the needs of our members and community. Hospitality here is only possible because our congregation works together. Thank you for the role you play in our community.

As the academic portion of the year comes to a close, we continue to give thanks to God for the ways he cares for and blesses his people. Blessings to those being confirmed May 3. Blessings to the women who will be honored on Mother's Day. Congratulations to our graduates. Thank you to those who made the ultimate sacrifice for our nation and are remembered on Memorial Day. There is much for which we are thankful, and they are all ways we experience the care and love that God has for his people.

VOTER'S MEETING SUNDAY, MAY 31ST

At the May 31st Voters Meeting, the congregation will be presented with a question about the future of Faith Christian Preschool (FCP). Currently FCP is operated through the Lutheran Schools Association, which also includes Trinity Elementary and NEW Lutheran High. At the conclusion of the 25/26 school year in June, the Association will disband and each school will operate independently. The Faith Church Council has agreed to assume operation of FCP as part of our church for the 26/27 school year. The congregation will be asked to determine the future of FCP beyond 26/27. Significant information about the history and current state of FCP will be shared, including financials. In the 5 years since Covid, FCP has lost money each year. Losses in just the last two years have been over \$20,000 each year and are expected to be even higher for the 26/27 school year. Faith will be able to operate the school next year through use of Mission funds, so it will not impact our annual budget. Beyond that, funding will be an issue, hence the need for this discussion.

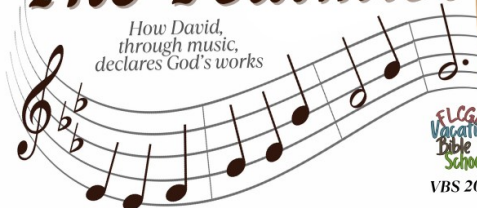

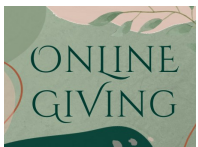
