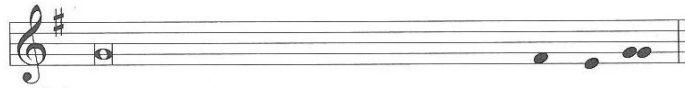
POST-COMMUNION COLLECT
