Generosity and thankfulness. They are the two sides of the same coin. Generosity springs from the gratitude and thankfulness you feel toward the life you have and the blessings that it contains. Thankfulness flows from the lessons you learn when you respond to the needs of your neighbors and are reminded of the many ways you have been blessed. One leads to the other and each one compliments the other.

When we practice stewardship, generosity and thankfulness are the outcomes of the skills and attitudes stewardship helps to develop. In the Bible, Jesus praises the widow who gives all she has to the temple and the Bible instructs that those who believe should give a tithe, or ten percent, of all that they have. Have you ever wondered why these models are held up to us as examples for the Christian life? It is because they give us a right understanding of the blessings God bestows on us every day. The way that we respond to the needs of others and to the needs of the church is an outgrowth of the ways that God has already blessed us. This is one of the reasons why Jesus praises the widow's offering; it might not have been much when compared to the other gifts that were given that day, but it was a generous portion of what she had received and she responded accordingly.

Generous living, stewardship, being charitable, or however you would want to define it, all teach us the same things; how to faithfully manage what we have in order to facilitate our generosity, and to remind us that God provides for his people. Giving from what we have is an act of faith. It is an act that requires us to believe that if we give up some of what we have been given, God will still provide what we need to support this body and life. Satan and the world around us would try to convince us that giving up some of what is "ours" is a foolish act. If we have earned it; we should enjoy every part of it.

The faithful Christian knows that our life is not measured in what we have earned but in the salvation that God has provided. What we store up in this life will be destroyed by moths and rust, but what God has given will last for an eternity. God blesses us in many and various ways while we live on this earth; for that we are thankful. May our thankfulness for all that God has given his creation, lead us all to act generously toward our neighbor that they might know the ways that God has blessed us. As we go through the month of November, be good managers of what God has given you, give thanks for what you have received, and respond generously with what God has given you as you seek to be His generous answer to someone else's prayer.

Men's Bible Study Tuesdays at 6:00 am in the Lounge




THANK YOU!






Missionaries are always in need of bibles. If you have extra bibles, new or used please consider supporting the Love Packages organization. Our collection tote is across from the mailboxes.


