Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I recently learned that April receives its name from the Latin verb, “aperire,” which means “to open.” It is believed to have been chosen as the name for the month because it is the time of year when the earth “opens up.” Hibernating animals emerge from their caves and nests. Buds begin to open on trees. Plants emerge from the ground. We open our windows to let in fresh air. We open our doors and spend more time outside. It is the time of year when things open once again.

Of course, when viewed through the lens of our Christian faith, there is no greater opening than the celebration of Easter. The open tomb causes us to open our mouths and proclaim that “Christ is Risen!” We open up and sing “Alleluia,” for the first time since February. The resurrection lets us feel like ourselves, once again.

The celebration of Easter lets us feel that way because Christians are a resurrection people. Jesus declares, in Matthew, that God is not the god of the dead, but of the living. We are most like what God designed us to be when we are celebrating the life that he gives to his people.

The Easter celebration is not just a celebration of the Jesus’ resurrection, the time when his tomb was opened. It is also a celebration of our Easter that has yet to come. We celebrate that God has promised that once day, Christ will return, and on that day all the tombs will be opened, and the great resurrection of the dead will occur so that we will have life everlasting. Body and soul, together, in the new creation.

We do not know when the Resurrection will occur, but as April reminds us every year, creation “opens up” according to God’s timing. He knows the day and the hour and, when the time is right, he will open up the heavens, and we will see his son return in glory.

Until that time comes, we celebrate the Easter of Jesus. It reminds us that we are the living to whom God has given eternal life. It reminds us of what God is doing for his people.

As we celebrate Easter this year, on April 5, be sure to also join us for the Easter breakfast between the two services. Then, continue that celebration of Easter through the seven weeks that follow, as we hear the Gospel stories that open up for us the truth of the resurrection. The accounts of Jesus appearing to the disciples after he was raised from the dead and their reactions to meeting the resurrected Lord. There is no better way to live in the month of April than to marvel with the church at how God has “opened up” heaven because of the work of his son.

Blessed Easter to everyone! Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!
Alleluia!
