
It was a hot summer day, and we were one hour into our daily four-hour practice. It was soccer training season, and practice was brutal. "Go!" My coach shouted. We were doing my *favorite* drill: octopuses. I write with a sense of sarcasm. In reality, running octopuses was the drill I dreaded most. It was a non-stop sprint from the center cone to one of the octopus' "leg" cones and back to the center. We repeated this back-and-forth sprint to the center cone until we visited each of the octopuses' legs. Unfortunately for us, octopuses have a lot of legs. For me, this drill signaled that we were once again in a season of preparation and training.

As a church, we will soon enter the preparatory season of Lent. What are we preparing for? We are preparing for Christ's resurrection on Easter Sunday and our own resurrection when Jesus comes again. Each of us are prepared and ready for Christ's return because the Holy Spirit has worked faith in our hearts to trust in the forgiveness and life that Christ freely gives. And yet, God continues to prepare us by strengthening us in that same Faith. Some of us may pick up practices like extra family devotions, or giving up sweets, meats, and Amazon purchases. Not too unlike the octopus drill, these practices may serve as a clear sign that the preparatory season of Lent has begun once again. They can remind us that our true strength in challenging times is God. We should never view such practices as mandatory or necessary for salvation, rather, God can use this preparatory season to discipline us and strengthen us in the faith, much like those drills helped disciplined my team.

This year, during the season of Lent, we will focus on a group of people who also entered a "season" of preparation. After departing from Egypt, the Israelites crossed the Red Sea and entered the wilderness where they spent 40 years in preparation. According to Google Maps, they could have made it from the Land of Goshen to Jerusalem in only seven days. So why the extra 39 years and 358 days? On account of their sin and disobedience, God knew they were not ready to enter the Promised Land. They would quickly turn away from God and rely on their own efforts. These years in the wilderness were far from easy. After all, they were living in a desert! God used these 40 years to strengthen their faith and trust in Him. Each day, God would provide them with the food and water they needed to live. Each day, God would lead them as the Pillar of Fire. The Israelites had to rely on God for survival. God was preparing them and strengthening their faith as they waited to enter the Promised Land.

As we look ahead to these next 40 days in the season of Lent, my prayer is that our time together, and our time with Moses in the wilderness, serve as a preparatory season in your life. God is sanctifying, literally setting you apart, as a Christian. He desires that you seek Him in His Word and be built up in His Sacraments. He alone has prepared you and continues to prepare you for His day of return





Join Moses and the Israelites on their exodus through the wilderness. In these 40 days of Lent, we learn with them how to look to God for our every need. As God prepares us to enter the Promised Land of Heaven, may He use this time to strengthen us in the Faith and deepen our trust in Him. ~Vicar Chase Greenhagen~
