As I was thinking about what to write for this month's newsletter, I received a call from my mom to share that one of my cousins had found my great, great grandfather Heinrich Irrer's (later changed to Errer) confirmation certificate (yes, he is the one that gave Henry our family name). He was baptized on August 2, 1873, and confirmed on April 14, 1889, at St. John Lutheran Church in Kilmanagh, MI, which is the same congregation my mom was baptized and confirmed in as a child, and about five miles away from the congregation he would later join where my great grandfather, grandfather, father, and myself would also be confirmed in over the years.

According to the certificate, his confirmation verse was Psalm 86:11, "Teach me your way, O Lord, that I may walk in your truth; unite my heart to fear your name." As we enter the second month of Christian Education classes, this is an incredible reminder of how important it is to continually study and grow in God's Word. When Heinrich was studying his own catechism 135 years ago, I doubt he considered that in 2024, in Green Bay, WI, his great, great, great grandson would also be studying "Luther's Small Catechism" as he grows in the Christian faith.

And yet, this is how the Christian faith is spread, generation to generation. One generation is growing in their faith as they are also teaching the next. In doing so, God is answering the prayer of David, for each new generation of the church by teaching His way that His people can walk in His truth. What is that way? It is, as Jesus said, that "I am the way, the truth, and the life, no one comes to the Father except through me (John 14:6)."

For those who are taught the way of God and then walk in his truth all the days of their lives, the great promise of salvation awaits. Upon their death, they are numbered among the hosts of heaven that now glorify God, see him face to face, and await the day when Christ returns to bring about the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come.

We are never separated from the saints who have gone before us. They are part of the company of heaven invoked in the liturgy before we sing, "Holy, Holy, Lord God of Sabaoth." They are the ones who defended and preserved the faith that we now hold. They are the ones through whom the Holy Spirit worked to promulgate and protect the church day after day, just as Christ had promised.

As we now stand in their place, learning to walk in the way of the Lord while we also teach those who are coming after us, we have no way of knowing what is yet to come. Since Heinrich's Confirmation Day, there have been 24 presidents, 2 World Wars, the development of the interstate highway system, electricity, space travel, the Internet, and countless other changes in culture and society. No matter how much has changed, however, the constant has always been our Savior. No matter how much will continue to change, He and his truth will remain the same, now and forever.

Tuesday Morning Bible Study Tuesdays at 9:30 am in the Lounge



God willing, we hope to do this project again at the end of next summer.











DO YOU HAVE A COPY OF THE LUTHERAN SERVICE BOOK (LSB)?

Next to the Bible what should be the next book that you have to encourage you in your faith? If we were able to ask Martin Luther he would probably say the hymnal—even though the first hymnals to be published during the Reformation began to appear exactly 500 years ago in 1524. Why would Luther say this? Perhaps the most obvious reason is that Luther himself wrote many of our hymns. He is credited with writing the texts for 27 our hymns, primarily with the goal of using them to teach about the faith, though some are paraphrases of the psalms. Being a skilled musician himself he is also responsible for the music for six of the hymns and recognized the power of music to help us learn and retain the important tenets of the faith. Whether you sing the hymns in the hymnal or just read them as devotional poetry, they help us to better understand the words of scripture and reflect on their meaning for us.

Beyond the hymns there is so much more of great value in the hymnal. Beginning with number (1) there are the psalms, the "hymnal" of the Old Testament, that are used in our worship throughout the church year. Following the psalms are the liturgies (151) that we use to structure our worship every week. For personal use in the home there are orders of daily prayer (294) and prayers for any occasion you could possibly need (305). Luther would also be very pleased to see that his Small Catechism is also included (321) which continues to be a guide for our faith long after we first studied it as children.



If you have read this far you may be asking the question – Why are you pointing out the value of the hymnals now? It is because the publisher of our hymnal, Concordia Publishing, offered them for a special price this last summer and Faith purchased extras to make them easily available to the congregation. Normally the list price is \$30, but you can purchase one from the church for only \$24. That will also save you the shipping fee which is often quite high because of the weight of books. If you don't yet have a *Lutheran Service Book* in your home, now is the time.
