Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at Faith Lutheran Church,

As I am writing this, the “false spring” we experienced in February has come to an end and the normal February weather has returned. For the week it lasted, the weather was glorious, warm and sunny and people seemed to be in better spirits because of it. And yet, when the normal weather returned, a general resignation of weather compliance also returned. Had we not had the false spring to which we could compare the normal weather, we would not have had the disappointment of a return to the cold.

But this doesn't mean we should disparage the false spring. Instead of seeing it as a lie of false hope, we should see it as a reminder of what is to come. The promise that winter doesn't last forever and the seasons will again change and bring new weather to complain about.

This experience is a good reminder of the ebbs and flows of life. Most of our days are just an average experience- the same as the one before and after with little variation. But this is what makes them average. We remember the aberration, the one that is different from the rest. The days when you are terribly sick or incredibly happy. But with those abnormal days an interesting thing happens; we don't often notice when our illness actually ends, but we resent when the exciting days do.

When living the Christian life, it can be tempting to resent the average days and only notice the highs and the lows. We remember Good Friday because we remember how it makes us feel as we grapple with the reality of what our sin does to our Lord. We remember Easter because of how the celebration of the resurrection makes us feel as we give thanks for what God has done. But these days are not the average, they are remembered because they are outside our normal experience. Except they aren't. They are the culmination of our average days brought together into one larger experience.

Each day you live has Good Friday in it. The repentance of your sin, the grief of death, the illness of a broken body; these are all reminders of our fall into sin and the need for Christ on the cross. But each day has Easter in it as well. Christ's triumph over sin, death, and the grave is experienced in the forgiveness only HE can give, the healing of your body from illness, the thankfulness that comes from God providing what we need to support this body and life.

We don't often notice it because they are the average days. But the average days are where we live so they are where Christ lives also. Thanks be to God this is so. To know that God is just as present in the average as he is in the aberration means that he is with you always, even to the end of the age. Give thanks for the average and rejoice in the “false springs” that come from time to time. They are the reminder that God has amazing things planned for his people and he has promised they are coming soon.
