Campus Ministry Goals

To assist with the evaluation of campus ministry success and priorities, the LCMS has identified five key targets for campus ministry:

- 1. **WORSHIP:** a Christian community gathering around Word and Sacraments to celebrate the Grace of God in Jesus Christ.
- 2. **NURTURE:** a Christian community growing in the Word and becoming equipped for service to the Lord and His church.
- 3. **OUTREACH:** a Christian community bearing witness to the gospel of Christ in Word and deed.
- 4. **FELLOWSHIP:** a Christian community strengthening and supporting one another in faith and life.
- 5. **SERVICE:** a Christian community caring for and serving others in love and friendship.

Therefore, guided by these targets and the vision of our congregation, the goals and priorities of the campus ministry provided by Faith Lutheran Church will be as follows:

<u>Worship:</u> Provide the opportunity for students to receive the gifts of God's grace by inviting them to join the local Christian community gathered around Word and Sacrament during the weekly Divine Service.

- Publicize service times through on-campus media
- Arrange travel for those without transportation to Faith or another local congregation

<u>Nurture:</u> Create and offer opportunities for students to engage in lifelong catechesis on their respective campuses that equips them for service to the Lord and His church.

- Offer a weekly, on-campus Bible study during the primary, academic year
- Provide support and encouragement in the pursuit of Christian vocation through in-person and electronic communication

<u>Outreach:</u> Proclaim hope to the campus community by bearing witness to the Gospel of Christ in Word and deed through faithfulness and acts of mercy.

- Provide counseling, when appropriate, to students who are struggling
- Witness to non-Lutherans and non-Christians through engagement opportunities on campus
- With the help of home congregations, identify and reach out to Lutherans studying in Green Bay
- Be present, if permitted, at parent engagement events to meet the support networks of incoming students

<u>Fellowship:</u> Encourage students to engage in forming relationships within a Christian community that will strengthen and support them in their walk of faith.

- Facilitate fellowship opportunities for on campus groups and multi-campus gatherings
- Provide an environment that allows students to develop meaningful relationships with other students of a shared faith and confession

<u>Service</u>: Learn to serve God and others through the vocations into which you have been placed by caring for and serving others in love and friendship.

- Encourage community service activities among students
- Engage students actively attending Divine Service in roles that support the work of a local congregation

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

LCMS-U is "an initiative to connect and support Lutheran students as they head off to college and face countless challenges to their biblical worldview, doctrine, ethics and practices (lcms.org)."

In other words, it is the way our church body seeks to care for our members who have graduated high school and are now navigating their entry into adulthood while at college.

For many students it is an important part of how they remain active in their faith during their time away from home and before they establish themselves in their new careers as professional adults.

Last fall, it was brought to my attention that while Green Bay is home to four different universities and colleges (UWGB, St. Norbert, NWTC, and Bellin College), there is no Lutheran ministry presence on any of the campuses. If students attending these schools wish to attend a Divine Service, participate in a Bible study, or meet other Lutherans with whom they can interact regarding issues of faith, there are on their own to figure out where that can happen. When this became known, the question was raised to me, why doesn't Faith do something then?

The first answer was, "because there is a closer church to each of the schools than what we are." Yes, while that is true, we are kind of in the center of all of them.

The second answer was, "We don't have the resources to do it at this time." Then, we received multiple, unexpected gifts, that can be used for mission work but not for our general budget.

Every time I gave a reason as to why Faith shouldn't be the one to address the issue of campus ministry in Green Bay, a response was given that took the reason away.

In February, the idea of engaging in campus ministry as a mission focus for our congregation was presented to the Board of Elders and the Church Council. Both groups were quick to offer their support in learning more about what this ministry would entail.

Since then, a budget has been developed, mission goals have been established, and resources have been identified that would make Lutheran campus ministry possible at all four colleges and universities in Green Bay.

Therefore, the Council is calling a special <u>Voters' Meeting on May</u> 19, after the second service, take up the issue of Faith Lutheran Church launching LCMS-U as part of our mission and ministry focus.

The meeting will address the following questions:

- Will the congregation adopt LCMS-U as one of our mission priorities?
- Will the congregation designate three years worth of funding to LCMS-U in order to give time to develop the mission and then evaluate its success in achieving its goals at the end of the three years?
- Will the congregation extend a call to Deaconess Deirdre Batiansila to serve as a missionary-at-large to the college campuses in Green Bay?

Along with these three formal decisions to be made by the congregation, there will also be opportunities for members to be involved in campus ministry as it develops. Students may need rides to church on Sunday mornings. All members can help welcome them to our congregation when they attend (as we should all visitors). We can all include students attending college and university in our prayers as they are navigating an exciting part of their lives, but also include this mission in your prayers as well.

As you try to imagine what this might look like in practice, the first page of this newsletter featured the working Campus Ministry Goals that are being developed to guide our work in this mission.

Please note, this may change prior to the meeting as it is a work in progress as of the middle of April. These are also the goals that will be used to evaluate the continued support and engagement in campus ministry during the third year of our work.

On a personal note, I can attest to the importance that campus ministry played in my own life. As an undergraduate, I attended Central Michigan University. On campus was a chapter of LCMS-U sponsored by Zion Lutheran Church in Mount Pleasant, MI. The students in that ministry became some of my closest friends and the members of that congregation provided a spiritual home away from home that helped shape the kind of pastor you have today. As I was nearing the end of my time at college, I asked one of the members of Zion why they invested in campus ministry. What did the congregation gain from the work that they did? His answer is one that I have never forgotten. He said, "we do this for you, because we hope someone else is doing it for our children, wherever they go to school. Besides, what you give us far exceeds what we could do for you. Each week our children attend service and see young adults engaged in their faith. They see that participation in a congregation happens, even after you leave home."


As we consider taking up the mission of campus ministry, that is my prayer as well. That we can do for other families and congregations what we hope they are doing for our students; providing a place where they can continue to grow in their faith, have their sins forgiven, and be a part of the Body of Christ, wherever they may be found.
