**HYGIENE DRIVE FEB 23-MARCH 16**

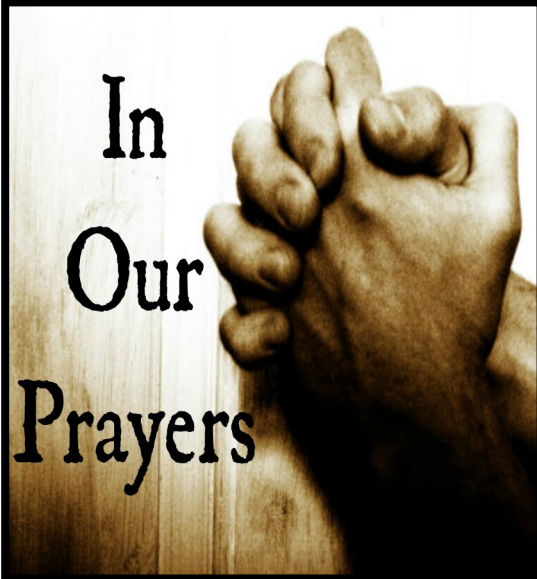


We are collecting new, unused personal hygiene and cleaning products through 91.9FM The Family's *Help for the Homeless Hygiene Drive*.
