

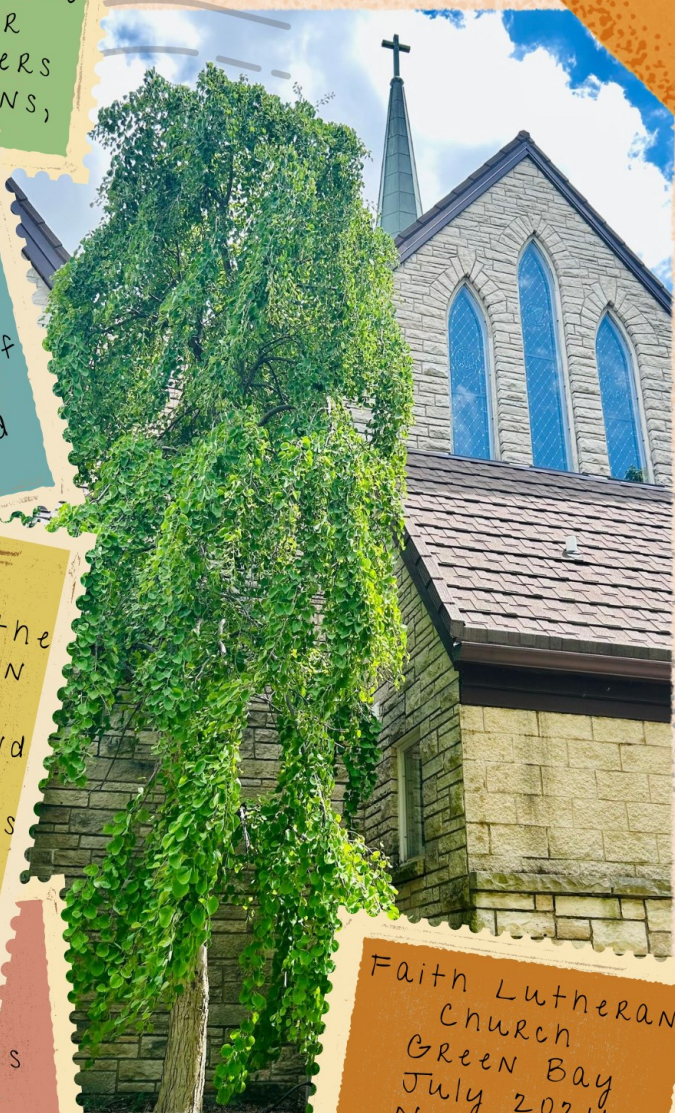

Time goes by fast. One more vicar has come, and now it's about time for that vicar to leave and for another to step in his place. I pray that my time serving you at Faith Lutheran has been of benefit to you. My aim and goal are to preach Christ Crucified. I hope that you have grown in faith, trusting ever more in the forgiveness that your Lord and Savior won for you on the cross. I pray that God continues to build you up by giving you a compassionate heart, discerning mind, and hands and feet that are ready to do the will of God.

Beginning July 21st there will be a list of perishable items (meats, cheese, veggies, fruit, bread, etc.) for members to pick from and drop off the week of July 29.

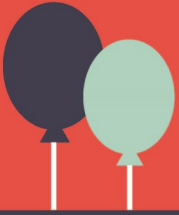
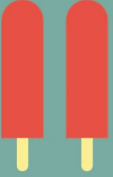
The below items can be dropped off in the bin labeled "Ebel Food Pantry" near the Church Office at any time.
