Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Back to school is upon us. School shopping is wrapping up and the welcome back activities have begun. Throughout the newsletter, you will find all kinds of information about the education opportunities within our congregation and the ways you are able to continually grow in your faith. While the Divine Service is and always should be the center of your interaction with the Word of God, it is the beginning of your interaction with God's Word, not the culmination of it. Bible study, individually, as a family, and with a group of other Christians should also be a regular part of your Christian life. You can think of this as continuing education for your faith. There is always more to learn about our God, what he has done to protect and preserve his creation, and how he continues to do that work for our benefit.

Continuing education is a blessing that continues to remind us that we are fearfully and wonderfully made. No matter how old we are or how much we have done, there is always more to learn and skills to develop. That is why many professions require regular continuing education so that people in those fields continue to improve throughout their career.

Pastors are no different when it comes to continuing education and professional development. I regularly attend conferences on various topics, and, as many of you know, I have been working on a doctorate degree for the last four years. This fall, I will take my final class before beginning work on the Major Applied Project (dissertation) for the degree. It will take about a year to complete. Thank you to those who have been encouraging me throughout this process.

This summer, Erica and I were asked by the North Wisconsin District (the geographical area of our church body that serves our congregation) to become continuing education facilitators for new pastors in our district. The program, called PALS which is short for Post-seminary Applied Learning and Support, is a three-year professional development program for new pastors and their wives. Each year, we will offer three conferences, covering a variety of topics, that deal with the practical aspects of leading and serving a congregation. When we went through this program fourteen years ago, we found it to be an incredible blessing and decided that if we ever had the opportunity to serve in this capacity, we would. We are very excited to lead the first conference in October.

Serving as facilitators of PALS happens while we continue to serve here at Faith. From a congregational perspective, the change you are likely to notice is that you will now hear about PALS from time to time because it will be a part of our life. Other than that, the work we do here will remain the same. Please keep us in your prayers as we expand our mentorship roles to help encourage and form the new pastors in the North Wisconsin District.

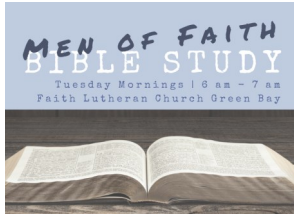

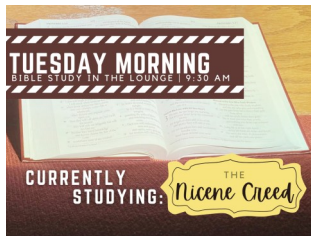
Men's Bible Study Tuesdays at 6:00 am in the Lounge

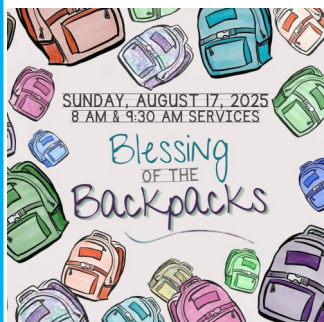


T.A.L.K. Bible Study

Do you play an instrument?

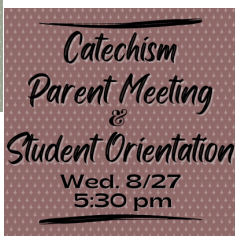

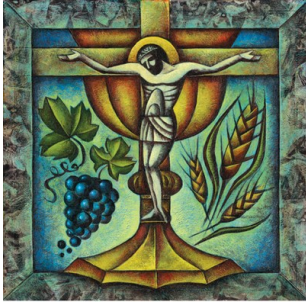
Please remember our mandatory orientation meeting with both parents and students is Wednesday, August 27th at 5:30 p.m. We will go through what the year will look like and what expectations are.
