Beginning Monday, October 5 at 5:30 pm, Pastor Error will be leading a 45 minute Bible Study. This four-week study doesn't tell Christians which political party to vote for. It sparks thoughtful and biblical conversation about voting in a democracy and our duty to do so as Christian citizens. *Called to Vote* reminds us that "we go to the polls informed by God's Word and our own best thinking. But we should never forget to distinguish between the two." Topics include:

- Distinguishing between God's Word and our own human judgments
- Distinguishing, but not separating, God's two modes of ruling
- Distinguishing oneself as ruled from oneself as "ruler"
- Repentance and involvement in politics
