2024 Voter's Guide

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at Faith Lutheran Church,

Now that your blood pressure is up or you have rolled your eyes at the thought of another voter's guide for this year's election, here is your guide: you are not electing a savior, make the best choices you can and pray for those who are elected. In summary, that is your guide.

To the first point, you are not electing a savior, this, above all else, is the most important guide you can have as a Christian filling out your ballot. It can be easy to lose sight of this. The commercials, the commentators, the conversations you have with family and friends, can make it seem as if everything is on the line and totally dependent on your voting choices. At the end of the day, however, when it comes to the most important things, the eternal things, God has already determined how they are to be dealt with; the death and resurrection of Jesus. No candidate or party is able to save you or offer you something greater than what Christ has already done. His gift of salvation is already yours. No one can give you something greater or provide you with more assurance than Jesus.

Does that mean that voting doesn't matter? No. It is simply the thing that keeps everything else in perspective. When you keep Christ's death and resurrection for the forgiveness of your sins as the primary focus of your hope and the center of your joy, it helps take the urgency out of the decisions being made in the election because the election does not change what God has done for you. However, because his death and resurrection is what gives you hope and joy, the decisions you make should reflect what he has done for you in the ways that you care for your neighbor.

Voting matters because it is our responsibility as citizens to vote, as is paying taxes, following the laws, caring for those around us. Voting matters, because it allows us to choose candidates that we think will create the best environment and situation for us to live our life of faith, unhindered by the pressures of the world and the influence of government. We should never take lightly the privilege and right we have in America to freely assemble and exercise our religion without the influence of government. Even more than our ability to gather on a Sunday morning, we are also free to love our neighbors by serving and caring for them. This is done by the actions we take, the decisions we make, and the way we vote. Our task is to protect the weakest and most vulnerable lives, care for the poor and destitute, and defend our neighbor against the attack of any enemy. Good government is one way that we can do this as a Christian neighbor.

At the end of the election, our responsibility as Christians will remain the same. Pray for those who have been elected, honor them according to the Fourth Commandment, and love our neighbor. No matter who we elect, they will not be a savior. No matter who we elect, they are and will continue to be sinners just like you and me. No matter who we elect, they will need our prayers. Go vote. Go and pray. It is your Christian duty for your neighbor.

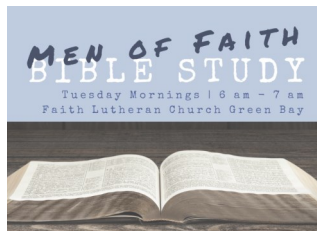

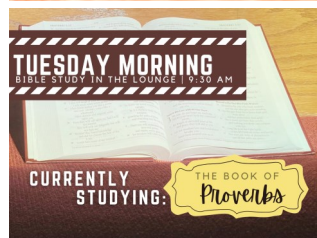
Men's Bible Study **Tuesdays at 6:00 am in the Lounge**

Morning Prayer is in the Sanctuary on Tuesday Mornings at 9 am. All are welcome.



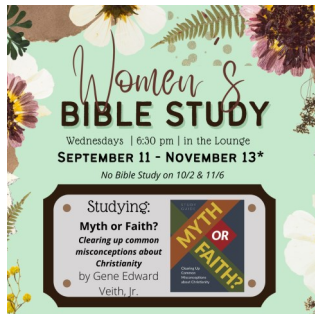
Tuesday Morning Bible Study **Tuesdays at 9:30 am in the Lounge**



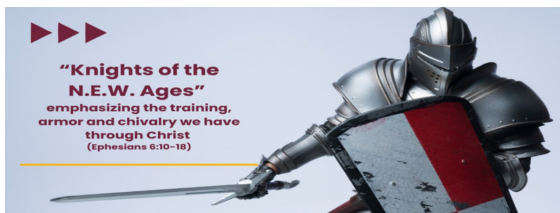

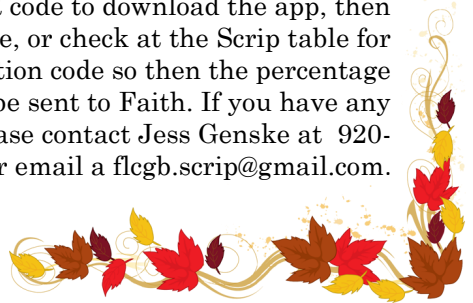
