Notice of a Special Voters' Meeting to be held on September 12, 2021 at 11:30 (following the Second Service).

At this meeting, we will consider the purchase of property and the amending of the constitution.

Motion for the purchase of property:

The Council moves to purchase property at 2347 S. Webster Ave. for no more than \$190,000 with the contingencies of an inspection, financing that includes no more than 5% interest on the loan with a minimum of 20% down, with the 20% down to come from current assets and financial holdings, with a separate maintenance fund to cover the cost of maintaining the property. The property is to be operated by a third party manager, held in a newly established LLC, and two of the three housing units must be used as rentals until the property is paid off.

Motion for the amending of the constitution (per the recommendation of the North Wisconsin District).

The Council moves to amend the Constitution and Bylaws to read:

- Under Article V. The Office of Pastor and Other Called Positions - After the last sentence, following the words "in addition to being qualified for the work of ministry" add: "and who have been endorsed by and are members of the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod."

- Under Article VI, Authority of the Congregation, section E. Removal From Membership – I would recommend adding the requirement that the excommunication of any person from membership would require a two-thirds majority vote of the voters assembly.

- Under Article VIII, Officers – I would recommend adding a section "c." which reads: "Any officer or board member who fails to carry out his or her duties of office or who fails to perform the responsibilities of confirmed membership may be removed from office by the voters assembly by a two-thirds majority vote, in Christian and lawful order. Matthew 18 should be followed under such circumstances."

NUT ALLERGY POLICY

As we resume activities, please review the Nut Allergy Policy that we have here at Church.

Purpose

As we face a growing number of children dealing with food allergies, including potentially life-threatening peanut and tree nut allergies, Faith Lutheran Church is committed to minimizing the exposure of our congregation's children to peanuts and tree nuts in our facility.

Guidelines

Faith Lutheran Church discourages the use of peanuts and tree nuts (Brazil nuts, almonds, cashews, pistachios, walnuts, pecans, hazelnuts, coconuts, etc.) or any foods containing these nuts, including their extracts or oils, in the **BASEMENT AREA**. The church and others holding children's events inside our facility are also asked to refrain from serving foods containing peanuts or tree nuts and their extracts or oils.

Policy Use

The use and application of this policy is fully subjugated to the constitution of Faith Lutheran Church. Any conflict between this policy and the constitution shall be governed by the constitution. This policy is administered by the Church Council on behalf of the members of Faith Lutheran Church. This policy may be revised or eliminated at any time in accordance with the governing administrative requirements.

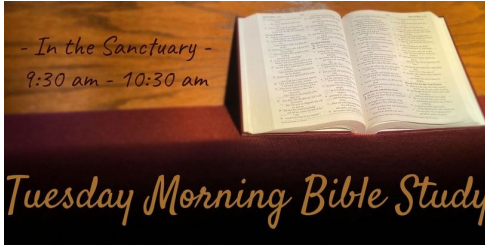

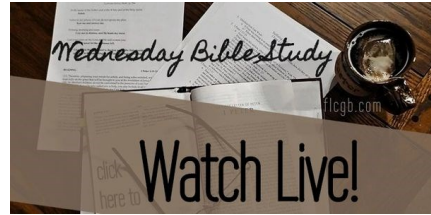

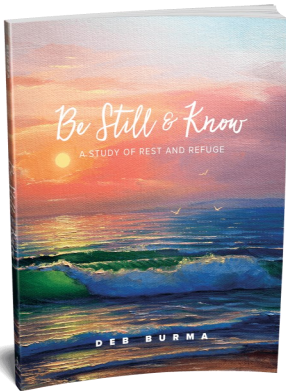

The first rehearsal for Adult Choir is on Tuesday, September 14th.

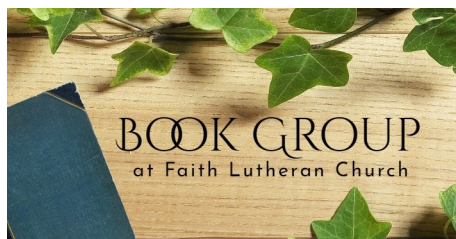
