Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at Faith Lutheran Church,

Advent calendars are a big part of our family life and tradition this time of year. The first gift each of our children receive from us is a calendar of their choosing to help count down for Christmas. These calendars are opened each morning as they wake up and help to build the anticipation toward the morning they awake to presents under the tree. We also have a family Advent calendar that is opened each evening, after we conclude dinner and devotions. This calendar is one of the traditional styled calendars that has compartments you can fill with whatever goodies you desire (Erica wisely started using leftover Halloween candy for this to help portion it out and use it up). As we open this calendar in the evening, we talk about waiting and how Advent helps us practice waiting for Christ's return on the last day.

This is the purpose of Advent- to serve as a season of preparation for the arrival of Christ. Often, we think about this in terms of preparing for our Christmas celebration. The time of baking cookies, decorating, purchasing gifts, wrapping presents, and tending to everything else on our to do list. As we come closer and closer to Christmas, the energy we put into the preparation seems to grow greater and greater and then, suddenly, Christmas is here whether we are ready for it or not.

In this same way we should be preparing for the Christ's second coming. God has warned us that the hour is at hand, and while we do not know the day or the time, he has promised it is coming soon. The day it comes will look like any other; the sun will rise and set, people will be going about their business, we will be doing as we have always done. Then, the heavens will break open, Christ will appear, angels will announce his arrival, and the Second Christmas will be here whether we are ready for it or not.


So how do we prepare? In some ways it is like how we prepare to celebrate Christmas every year. Wake each day with anticipation that Christ is coming soon. Gather your family for devotions and hearing the Word of God to talk about how you are waiting for what is to come. Care for and show love to your neighbor; not just through buying gifts and wrapping presents, but through your actions and deed as well (love your neighbor as yourself). Most importantly, gather with your family to celebrate together. Each week the family of God (yes, your church family), gathers to celebrate that Christ has come and look forward to his coming again. You should

not ever desire to miss it. Just as our earthly family celebrations shape our observation of Christmas, so too the gathering of our spiritual family shapes our preparation of the Christmas to come as we look forward to "the resurrection of the body and the life of the world to come."

I pray you all have a very blessed Advent.
