Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“Blessed Lord, who has caused all Holy Scriptures to be written for our learning, grant that we may in such wise hear them, read, mark, learn and inwardly digest them, that by patience and comfort of Your Holy Word we may embrace, and ever hold fast, the blessed hope of everlasting life, which You has given us in our Savior, Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. Amen.”

I love the phrase, “hear them, read, mark, learn, and inwardly digest them,” that appears in this prayer. It is a reminder to us of how we should interact with and utilize the Word of God. When God spoke, first through the prophets and then through his Son, he did not speak frivolously or carelessly. He gave us his Word and he promised it would be effective- it would do something. The something it does is makes you his child, forgives your sins, and keeps you steadfast in your faith. For it to do this, however, you must encounter his Word. If you refuse to hear it, refuse to read it, refuse to interact with it, you also refuse any of the benefits it might give. So we are called, as his children to have God’s Word be a part of our lives so that it make shape us and make us his.

While this is an ongoing activity that happens over the course of a lifetime- you will never learn all there is to know- during the Sundays in March, we will be highlighting some of the ways Faith supports Christian Education and the interaction with God’s Word for some of our younger members. On March 7, we will welcome representatives of Camp Luther who will be with us to share about the work of our partners in outdoor ministry and how they share God’s Word with those who attend Camp each year.

On March 14, we will focus on Christian Education within our schools. During services on this Sunday, we will welcome the North East Wisconsin Lutheran School Association to share with us about the work of Trinity Lutheran School and NEW Lutheran High School. These two institutions, working alongside Faith Christian Preschool, are devoted to helping families prepare Christian leaders and are one of the ways that Faith is able to help families encourage their children to engage with God’s Word and inwardly digest all he has to say.

Finally, on March 21, we will have Examination Sunday. This is the culmination of Sunday School and Catechism Class as our Eighth Grade Confirmands publicly answer questions about the Christian faith, practice speaking to others about what we confess, and demonstrate what they have learned thus far in their Christian Education journey. Please keep these students in your prayers as they prepare for this day.

Christian Education should always be a priority for the Christian. After Christian worship, it is the most important part of deepening your relationship with your Heavenly Father. We come to worship to receive his gifts and we participate in Christian education to learn how to “embrace and hold fast the blessed hope of eternal life.”

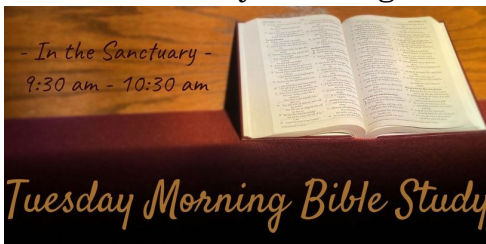

## News from the Library

Three new books have been added to the church library that deal with challenging and sensitive subjects. Each book provides reflection questions and the opportunity to engage God's Word as you struggle with the subjects they pursue.

- **"He Remembers the Barren,"** by Katie Schuermann. Schuermann takes up the challenge of addressing the topic of childlessness in marriage. Addressing questions raised by those who struggle with infertility, she has created a devotional that helps women anchor their identity in Christ while considering the longing they feel to be a mother of their own children. In doing this, Schuermann has "given voice to those who are barren but not broken," and who often struggle to fit in a world designed to celebrate the gift of children.
- **"Never Forsaken,"** by Kathryn Ziegler Weber. Weber has collected the stories of loss and grief and allowed women to share their journey through miscarriage in this compelling devotional. Each chapter can stand on its own and does not need to be read in sequence. For anyone who has ever asked the question of, "Why?" when confronting the loss of their unborn child, Weber helps show love and hope to those in the darkness of grief.
- **"How Long, O Lord?"** by Kristin Vargas. Written to address the hurt and trauma that often follows the return home of a war veteran, Vargas expands on this topic to include the devastation that a broken world brings into the lives of those who are first responders, survivors of abuse, and those ravaged by natural disasters. Through her devotional work, she seeks to provide hope to those deeply hurt in ways many others are not able to understand.

# Camp Luther will be here Sunday, March 7!

Camp Luther has taken precautions to ensure a safe, yet meaningful time at Camp this Summer. There are a few of their adjustments listed below, or to find out more about how they are going about Summer Camp, go to:

## Decreased Capacity

We're limiting our on-site capacity to 60% to give campers room to spread out in housing areas and shared spaces.



## Separate Cohorts

Cohorts consisting of two camper groups (maximum of 24 campers) will be pre-assigned and used throughout the week for any shared activities as required. (Swim times, athletic field games, rainy day indoor locations, etc.)



## Face Coverings

Campers and staff will be asked to wear face coverings in any indoor locations shared by different groups.



## Small Groups

Camper groups will be limited in size to a maximum of 12 campers and small groups will remain separate throughout the camper week.



## Health Screenings

All campers will be asked to complete a pre-camp health screening process.



## Enhanced Cleaning

Enhanced cleaning protocols will be used for shared spaces and commonly touched surfaces.



## Group Separation

Any large group activities will be restricted to outdoor activities where adequate separation between different groups can be maintained.



## Contactless Check-In

Camper check-in and pick-up will be a contactless process conducted entirely in the Camp Luther parking lot.



## Separate Bathrooms

Each small group will either be assigned their own bathroom area, or will be assigned morning and evening bathroom times at a shared showerhouse to limit mixing between groups during these times.

One big change is that they are limiting the number of on-site campers each week to 60% of our normal capacity. This change, combined with restrictions in camper group sizes, means that we'll be limiting the number of specialty programs we offer this summer. So this means that spots will fill up fast, so register for Camp today!
