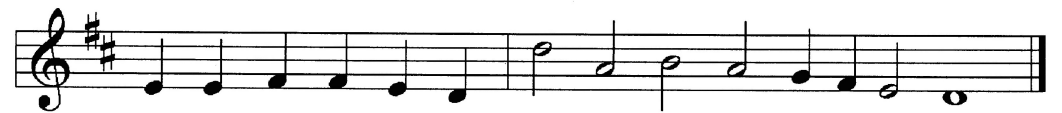

**John 20:1-18**

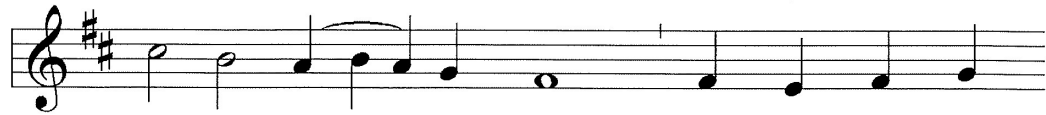

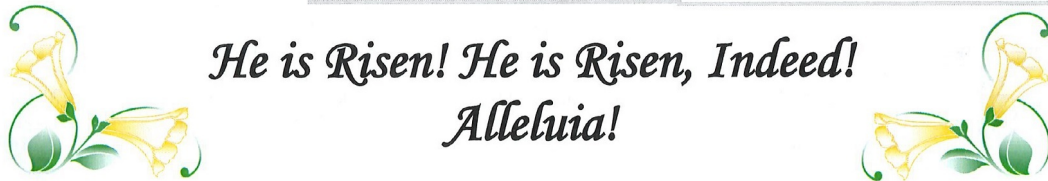

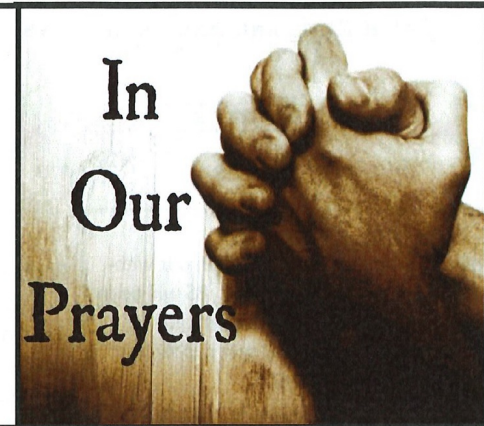
**Trinity 2021 UnAuction is April 17!**
