- 4. Paul says in verse 6 that "while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord." Is this true? How do we understand what Paul is saying here?
- 5. How does verse 9 explain, in simple terms, the life-long goal of a Christian?
- 6. What will happen when we appear before the judgement seat of Christ? What passage from the Gospels helps explain this most clearly?

Read 2 Corinthians 5:11-17

- 7. What is the "fear of the Lord" and how does it motivate our actions?
- 8. Reading this section of 2 Corinthians, what can we learn about what had been going on in Corinth, prompting this letter from Paul?
- 9. According to verse 14, what controls Paul's actions? How can we see this playing out in our lives today?
- 10. What does Paul mean when he says "we regard no one according to the flesh?"
- 11. What does it mean to be a new Creation in Christ?
