## What do you think of when you hear the word 'Evangelism?'

When I stopped to ask myself this question several things came to mind. People in dress shirts ringing doorbells with pamphlets in hand and a memorized pitch. Facebook posts asking, "How many people have YOU talked to about Jesus this week?" I even recalled a moment from my honeymoon; my wife and I stood in line for a concert while people with megaphones proclaimed a fire-and-brimstone message as concertgoers avoided their gaze. All of these people mean well by their efforts. I'm sure many of us (myself included) would not be chomping at the bit to get our hands on the megaphone or knock on a door.

Many have overcorrected in response to these tactics and avoid the act of evangelism entirely. We find ourselves hesitating to discuss the Faith in settings with friends and family. Our temptation, especially in the modern American context, is to consider our spiritual life as a private thing and extend that same thought to our neighbors (meaning everyone else). "I have my beliefs, and they have theirs." Have you ever shared the fact that you are a Christian with someone, only to be met with "Oh, good for you"?

The Christian faith, while ideally consisting of private elements like a devotional life, is inherently a public affair. We gather publicly as the Church; to receive the Word preached and delivered through the Sacraments. We sing together, confess together, and kneel at the altar together.

*What, then, is the place of Evangelism in the life of a Christian?*

Do we need to start practicing speeches and knocking on doors today? The answer to the second question is no. The answer to the first will be the goal of a series of bulletin inserts like this one provided by the Evangelism Committee here at Faith Lutheran Church. For the next few months, we will explore the role of Evangelism for us Lutherans. We will consider the Gospel we proclaim, and the people around us in need of this good news. While Evangelism can seem intimidating, we pray you are encouraged by what Holy Scripture, our Lutheran Confessions, and experienced evangelists have to offer us as we reconsider the place of evangelism in our lives.

As you read these snippets, we invite you to reflect upon them and reach out to the Evangelism Committee. No questions are off limits, and all feedback is welcome. We are here to serve you, our community, and ultimately to serve the mission of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
