"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son..." These words are the picture of grace in action. They are also the perfect summary of Christmas.

Grace is receiving something you did not earn or deserve. Because of this, it is the perfect Christmas word. Christmas gifts, given from parents to children, reveal how grace works. No matter how many times a parent might threaten their child or promise to take away their presents, almost every child is confident that on Christmas morning, presents will be under the tree. Why? Because the child knows his parents love him and that is enough for presents to come.

A child's Christmas gifts are not earned or deserved. They are given out of love. So too is the Son of God. We have done nothing to deserve the gift the Father gives to his people and yet, in a manger, the Son of God is wrapped in swaddling clothes; a gift from God to you. He gives his son because he loved the world. No other reason is necessary other than His love.

The gift of Jesus is not just for those who do the right things, wear the right things, or have earned a reward. The gift of Jesus is for the whole world, even those who do not believe. God still gives his Son to them. Jesus will still die for them. The difference is that those who do not believe will perish and they will not have eternal life.

This stark reality comes because, while you cannot stop someone from giving you a gift, you can choose not to open it, use it, or receive the benefits of it. For those who reject Christ and his forgiveness, the gracious gift of Christmas does not do them any good. But for those who believe, those who receive God's gift of grace and who live with its blessings, you will not perish but have eternal life. No greater Christmas gift could ever be given.

Throughout this Advent season, we will be exploring the depths of God's love through the First Epistle of St. John. In this letter, he explains the depths of God's love and teaches the church, teaches, why it matters. The staff has written an Advent/Christmas devotional book for use in the home, and the mid-week services will all focus on this theme as well.

The devotion book will not end with Christmas Day but also take you through the twelve days of Christmas. This year, we will celebrate the completion of the Christmas season with an Epiphany service on Tuesday, January 6. Epiphany rejoices in the revelation of who Jesus is and that he has come, not just to the Jews, but for all people.

May your Advent and Christmas season be filled will joy and cheer but most of all, may each gift you receive remind you of the greatest Christmas gift ever given, the Son of God.

#### Adult Bible Study Sun. | 9:15 am Fellowship Hall




Singing through the Order of Matins is in the Sanctuary on Tuesday Mornings at 9 am. All are welcome.

We pray that it was an educational time to refocus on the Light of the World - JESUS!




