Based on the words of Martin Luther's Baptismal "Flood Prayer," spoken during baptisms, the "Holy Ark of the Christian Church," brings to life the content of our prayer. Peeking over the edge of the boat are believers protected from the tumultuous waters of the sinful world. They are kept safe in the church, which is built on the teaching of the Apostles, and under the protection of the Risen Lord. The waves of death are conquered by the sacraments that flow from Christ himself.




