SPECIAL APPEAL: LCC DEPLOYING TO TEXAS AFTER CATASTROPHIC FLOODING

Lutheran Church Charities is planning to deploy to the Texas Hill Country this week to BE THERE to offer HOPE TO THE HURTING after catastrophic rains, rapid rises in river levels, and massive flash flooding overwhelmed multiple communities over the July 4 weekend, taking the lives of more than 80 people, including at least 28 children at campgrounds along the Guadalupe River basin.



Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod Texas District President Rev. Dr. Jon Braunersreuther and Texas District Disaster Response Coordinators Julie Tucker and David Ricks have invited LCC to lend Disaster Response expertise and bring K-9 Comfort Dog, Hearts of Mercy & Compassion ministries, and LCC Care Teams trained in Spiritual First Aid™ to the Texas Hill Country to provide physical, emotional, and spiritual care to those affected by the still-unfolding tragedy.



LCC can provide this assistance because of faithful, generous donors and volunteers who are willing to support and serve. "The financial support you can offer right now will go directly to helping families and LCMS congregations in the Texas Hill Country and bring **HOPE TO THE HURTING**," Rev. Singer said.
