Evangelism in the Household
The power of the Small Catechism

Often, we consider evangelism as something done outside the doors of the church building. The task is to share the gospel, the Word of God, with others, that by hearing it the Holy Spirit would call them to faith and repentance. This is a way in which we love our neighbor. Last week, we discussed the unique Christian virtue of hospitality as evangelism. While part of hospitality is indeed a reaching out to and loving the stranger, another part is caring and providing for those we know. Hospitality can be, and should be, practiced very well inside the Church. In fact, we are called to do so: "Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality." (Romans 12:13)

Consider the warm welcome we seek to give to our new Vicar, Nathaniel Hall and his family. We want them to know that we love and appreciate them and are glad to have them as a part of our lives for the next year. Consider what you see when you enter Faith Lutheran Church on a Sunday morning. The welcome center, attended to by faithful and hospitable saints, providing coffee and cookies with a smile and a genuine care for everyone coming through the door. This is a mark of hospitality that serves everyone; those who are entering the church for the first time, as well as those who have been members for forty years. These things flow from faith and thanksgiving, as does all evangelism.

It is not just the person volunteering at the welcome center who can and should show hospitality. Like me, you may recognize a lot of faces even if you struggle to remember the name. We can engage in truly meaningful hospitality by simply re-introducing ourselves to others, asking them to remind us of their name, and getting to know them better. Remember who you are, and who the person next to you is. "For you are a people holy to the Lord your God. The Lord your God has chosen you to be a people for his treasured possession, out of all the peoples who are on the face of the earth." (Deuteronomy 7:6).

We each bring our struggles, trials, sins, and worries with us to worship, offering them up to the Lord in faith that we will be forgiven, strengthened, and comforted by his gifts in Word and Sacrament. We as Christians have the unique opportunity to comfort one another each time we gather. By getting to know the people around you and building relationships, we comfort and are comforted. As we are God's people gathered around his gifts, we should learn to know and love one another in fellowship and care. Pray for each other and ask to be prayed for. In this way we mutually encourage each other's faith. Having a loving family in Christ will be a great benefit to you as you evangelize to others near and far.
