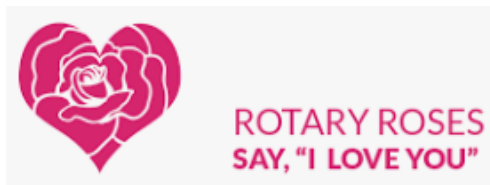

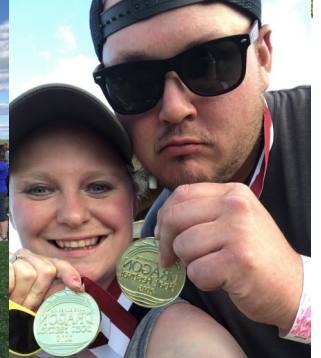

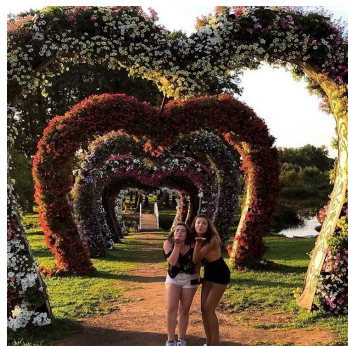
Sofi arrived in Minnesota in early August. She is from Cancun, Mexico. She is fitting right in at the Hanson house and has already started practice with the volleyball team.
