The Santa Fe County Community Services Department includes the following three divisions: Health Services, Senior Services and Youth & Family Services.

The Community Services **Health Services Division** includes the following programs:

*CONNECT* is a network of clinics, community organizations, and city and county programs who link people to services and resources in our community.

*The Health Care Assistance Program (HCAP)* provides support for health care for individuals who qualify as low income, as well as contractual projects to support the priorities of the Health Action Plan to link individuals by connecting them with the clinical care and community services they need to stay healthy, leading to improved community health.

The Santa Fe County Community Services Department is striving to provide a strong continuum of *Behavioral Health* care for Santa Fe County residents that can and will positively impact homelessness, overcrowding in the jail, improved public safety, congested emergency rooms, and access to quality health and behavioral health care within our community.
