BIKE SHOW RULES AND GUIDELINES

Bike Show will be in the parking lot of the Red Lion. Roll in 1:00 p.m. All applicants agree to have motorcycle on display on Sunday, October 13 at 2:00 p.m. until completion of the show at 3:00 p.m. Stickers will be assigned for your headlight for judging. Motorcycle shall not be moved during show without permission of BBW. If you leave early from the event, you will forfeit your show position and will not receive the award for your class.

- * All motorcycles must be operable.
- * This is a family event; please do not display offensive material. If it's questionable, put a cloth over it.
- * Awards If you win, we will need a picture of you and your bike.
- * Safety - No fuel leaks allowed.
- * No fire ups during show.
- * The judges' decisions are final!
- * No talking to the judges, unless they ask you a question. This can lead to disqualification.
- * Judges reserve the right to move a motorcycle to another class at their discretion.

Classes may change from one year to the next. Suggestions for new classes are always welcome.
