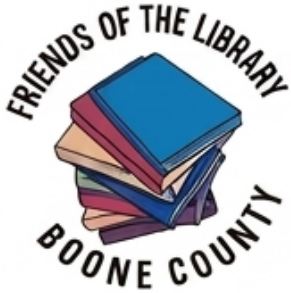

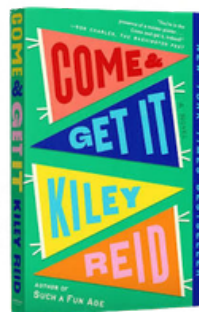

MAKE A FAMILY TREE WITH A GENOGRAM

A genogram is a detailed graphic representation of a family tree that goes beyond basic lineage. ***It uses standardized symbols and includes important information such as relationships, health histories, cultural backgrounds, and career patterns.*** Genograms are used to analyze family dynamics and significant patterns across generations.

Join us for a hands-on genogram workshop. Participants will create their own genograms while gaining insight into family connections, emotional patterns, and health history. This interactive experience focuses on paper-and-pen techniques, making it personal, reflective, and accessible—no computer required. **Building a genogram requires information across two-three generations (you, your parents, and if possible your grandparents). You need to gather basic demographic facts (names, birthdates, marriages, and divorces) and specific background details relevant to your goals, such as medical conditions or family relationship dynamics.**

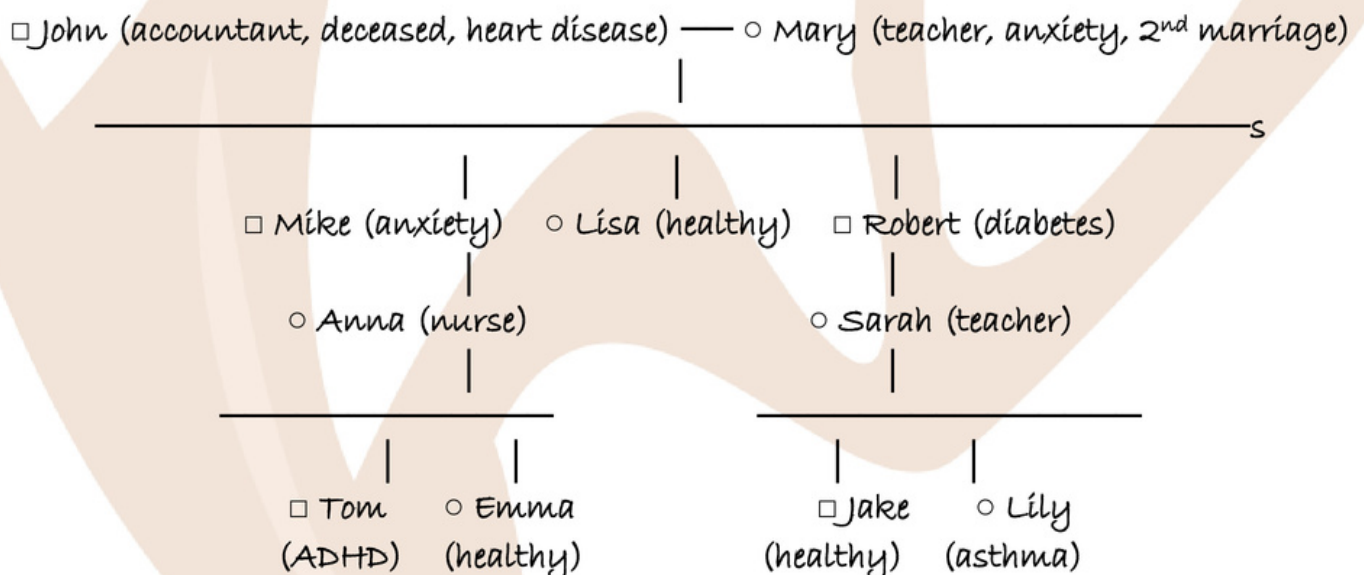
