After-School Programs are Thursdays at 4 p.m. for ages 6-12.



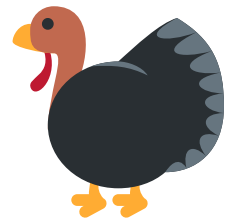
November 3rd- Hedgehog Pinecones- make an adorable hedgehog out of pinecones

November 8th- Thankful Pumpkins- Create a pumpkin with all the words you're thankful for! This is a great way to show your gratitude this fall.

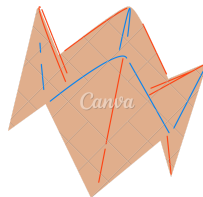


November 15th- Fabric Pumpkins- We are excited to have Anna Martin back to do a special craft with fabric and pumpkins. All supplies will be provided.

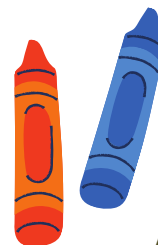
