Boone County Library 3D Printer Guidelines

The Anycubic 3D Printer was donated to the library by Ed Boston.

Rules for 3D Printer usage:

- You must be at least 18 years old or have a parent accompany you if under 18.
- Must have a Boone County library card (in good standing)

- The Library has a selection of 1.75mm PLA+ filament that is free to patrons. If you want colors we do not have, you may bring your own. We do not currently have any PETG available. (we only allow 1.75MM PLA or PETG Filament to be used)

- The item that you are printing must be finished printing no later than 4:30 pm on Monday, Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday or 6:30 on Tuesday or Thursday.

- Your item must be appropriate for all audiences, since you may have many people interested in observing the printing process.

- No WEAPONS of any kind may be printed.

- You will not be permitted to use the Library's 3D printer to create material that is:

- Prohibited by local, state or federal law.
- Unsafe, harmful, dangerous or poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others. (Such use may violate the terms of use of the manufacturer.)
- Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the Library environment.
- In violation of another's intellectual property rights. For example, the printers will not be used to reproduce material that is subject to copyright, patent or trademark protection

- You must take a class from Matt, or be approved by him to use the printer. You may contact him at <u>3dprinter@boonecountylibrary.org</u> to setup a time.

- You must make an appointment with the director before you can use the 3D Printer.

- Appointments for the 3D Printer are available on a first come first serve basis.

- The library is not responsible for any failed prints, electrical, or technology issues.

- We will give you some basic troubleshooting tips, but if something goes wrong, please don't do anything that involves disassembling printer hardware. Doing so will result in loss of privileges to use the machine. Please let us know if a problem pops up and we will help! - You must design, scan, create, or download your own models for use on the 3D printer; library staff is available for assistance only.

- Our printer has a size limit of 220mm × 220mm × 250mm (8.5" × 8.5" × 9.5")

- You understand that there is a possible burn hazard.

- You agree that when using the 3D Printer, you will stay with the machine for the duration of its use and never leave it unattended.

- You must report any accident/incident that occurs to the library staff.

- Barring normal wear and tear, you agree to accept financial responsibility for damage and/or loss of items in part or total.
