All artworks must in some way relate to the theme of International Women's Day - celebrating womanhood. Preference will be given to local artists.

Due to the limited space available, 2D artworks must be smaller than 1m<sup>2</sup>, and 3D artworks must be no higher than 1.5m and stand on a base of no more than 1m<sup>2</sup>.

All artworks must be supplied framed ready to hang (D-rings and cord) and presented in a professional manner (works on paper should be framed behind glass, but stretched canvas will be considered framed).

All artworks must be clearly marked with artist's name, contact number, price and title on back.

All care will be taken by curators to include all accepted artworks, however curators reserve the right to choose not to hang an artwork for any reason.

A commission rate of 25% will be requested from artworks commissioned or sold (not exhibition pieces) as a direct result of the exhibition.

Participating artists agree that images of their artworks included in the exhibition may be used in social media and marketing material to promote International Women's Day Exhibition.

It is the responsibility of the artist to deliver artworks and collect unsold works in keeping with the timeline supplied.
