**\*\*Some rules (there are always rules!):**

- \*Only 10 picture entries per resident and landscape format
- \*Have sufficient resolution to be printed on an 8.5 x 11inch page.  
(In general, a jpeg file size of at least 3MB or 300 DPI will be adequate, but final determination will be made based upon the image quality.)
- \*Include no people— due to privacy and issues of permissions
- \*Winning entry owners must agree to allow their photos to be printed

The HOA approved the project. The cost will again be a \$10 donation for each calendar. Our goal is to have them ready about the first week in November.
