Dog safety: These are the things you should NOT do around a dog you do not know:

Never hug or pet a dog you don't know

Never approach a dog when it is playing with a bone

Never disturb a dog while he is sleeping or eating his food

Never approach a dog with her puppies, in a car, or tied up outside a store

Never squeeze or grab a dog

Never try to pick up a strange dog

Your dog is part of the family. He is happiest when he is with you. Make sure to include him in your big events and make him feel special!



Dog safety: These are the things you should do around a dog you do not know:


Always ask the owner AND the dog permission to pet him

Always keep your face away from a dog

Always report anyone you see being cruel towards any animal

Always be gentle and treat the dog with kindness so he knows you are a friend

Always listen to signals from the dog, remember they can't speak to you any other way
