Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP)

PRP therapy has been used for various medical procedures for well over 20 years. There have been many studies done on this therapy for wound healing and sports injuries. Its use in medical esthetics and dermatology is now expanding. More studies specifically for PRP in esthetics are forthcoming. Evidence at this time is mostly based on clinical outcomes and expert opinion. Nonetheless, PRP treatment has already been shown to work as a catalyst, enhancing production of both stem cells and fibroblasts.

PRP Applications in Esthetics

PRP is especially used for conditions like facial and neck rejuvenation, fine lines and wrinkles, abdominal striae and facial scarring, and alopecia (hair loss) / hair thinning.

PRP Applications - Medical

PRP treatment is done to stimulate healing which involves injection of one's own growth factors into injured areas.

Uses for PRP in musculoskeletal medicine include treatment of tendonopathy, tendonosis, acute and chronic muscle strain, ligament sprains and intra-articular injuries and joint pain such as osteoarthritis and knee meniscus damage.



Dermal fillers help to diminish facial lines and restore volume and fullness in the face.

As we age, our faces naturally lose subcutaneous fat. The facial muscles are then working closer to the skin surface, so smile lines and crow's feet become more apparent.

The facial skin also stretches a bit, adding to this loss of facial volume. Other factors that affect the facial skin include sun exposure, heredity and lifestyle.

What dermal fillers can do?

- Plump thin lips
- Enhance shallow contours
- Soften facial creases and wrinkles
- Improve the appearance of recessed scars
- Reconstruct contour deformities in the face

SkinPen® Microneedling

Microneedling is also referred to as collagen induction therapy. As we age, we experience a loss in collagen and elastin resulting in wrinkles, thinning skin, and increased risk from sun damage.

The SkinPen® sets the gold standard as a medical grade microneedling device used to treat melasma, acne scars and surgical scars. It is also used to improve fine lines and wrinkles, stretch marks, hyperpigmentation, age spots, and hair loss.

The treatment can be combined with SkinPen Treatment kit and other treatments such as PRP and hyaluronic acid fillers for enhanced results.

Microdermabrasion

Microdermabrasion is the "polishing" of the skin, specifically the stratum corneum and granulosum. The process involves abrading the skin with a diamond encrusted tip, that is attached to a wand, which acts like a vacuum, removing all the dead skin, congestion from pores, and stimulates elastin and collagen back into the skin, helping to tighten the skin and reduce the appearance of fine lines and wrinkles.

Benefits from regular treatments include:

- Reduction in the appearance of fine lines & wrinkles
- Reduction of acne scars
- Evens colour & complexion of the skin
- Skin will look rejuvenated—more smooth & firm
- Pores will be less noticeable
- More even skin tone

Facial / Chemical Peels
