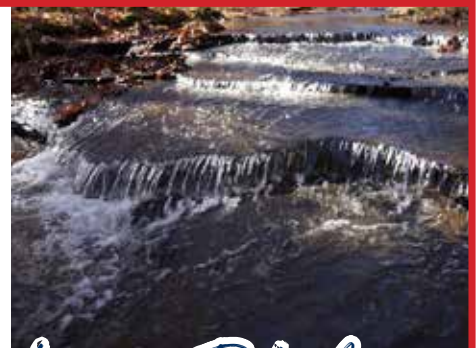

Victoria Reed never imagined how well her entertainment background and the years she spent traveling the world doing USO shows would prepare her for her role as Director of Performing Arts at the Williamson County Performing Arts Center.

Since arriving in Franklin nearly seven years ago, Reed has worked to add live musical performances. That includes a series of tribute shows honoring musical groups and theatrical productions, four of which she directed. And among those four, two were shows

she wrote, including “Sweet Soul Music,” which finished in April.

“It ended up being a bit of a hit, which was very exciting,” Reed says. “It had a cast of twelve. Four of the leads were black, and we had a mixed choir because when Ray Charles did ‘I Can’t Stop Loving You,’ he had a huge choir behind him, and I wanted to do it as authentically as possible.”

She has a reputation for doing extensive research on all of her productions.

“I believe it’s my job to not only entertain, but to teach. I call it infotainment. So, I put in a lot of history about the songs, and I did

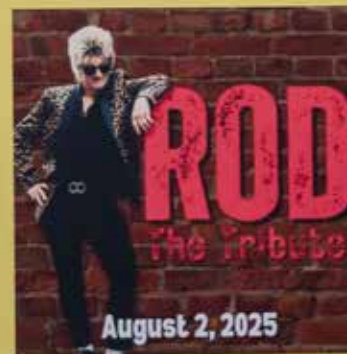

that especially with "Sweet Soul Music."

Reed has always been passionate about blending music and theater. After graduating from college, the Massachusetts-native headed to New York to pursue her dream of acting on Broadway. But as she started getting traction, she felt the need to do something more meaningful.

"I moved to New York after getting a musical theater degree, but early on, the journey started getting old. I was taking voice lessons, vocal coaching, and dance lessons, and it felt like it was all about me. I started getting callbacks for roles like the mother in "Tommy" and other things, and I had already done a bunch of national tours and my

own show on cruise ships, but I felt empty inside."

Then, she saw an advertisement for female performers to tour veterans' homes and hospitals for Christmas. She auditioned and got the job. Her first performance changed her life.

"The front row was mostly veterans who had lost their legs, and many were World War II veterans," she recalls. "And when we went to sing 'God Bless America,' I'll never forget the feeling I had when I saw those men trying to stand up. It was the most amazing thing I'd ever witnessed. I realized singing for them made my heart happy, and it wiped out the emptiness I'd been feeling."

Reed took over management of the group, and in the years that followed, moved up the ranks at the USO. She ended up traveling the

globe to entertain those who serve.

"It was a labor of love," she says. "I'm really proud of my work with the military and veterans. My dad was a World War II veteran."

She eventually left the USO and became the Bob & Dolores Hope Director of Entertainment at the National WWII Museum in New Orleans. While there, she produced, directed, and wrote several original shows.

After nearly a decade in Louisiana, Reed's father passed away, and her mother became ill, and she decided she needed a change. She left to spend time with her mom and see what might happen next. Within three weeks, her husband spotted the Williamson

County opening.

Reed remembers him saying, "I've been reading about Franklin, Tennessee, and it's really beautiful there."

She applied and got the position, with the goal of helping the small, 265-seat theater broaden its role.

"When I showed up, this was primarily a children's theater and rental venue. And the director, Gordon Hampton, wanted it to be a more even piece of the pie and offer more to the community."

Reed has certainly been successful in doing that.

"We're all seeking purpose, so if you find something in your life that really touches your heart, you're very lucky. And to have the opportunity to work, direct, and create something is magical. And taking people on a journey is so much fun." For info visit www.wcpactn.com

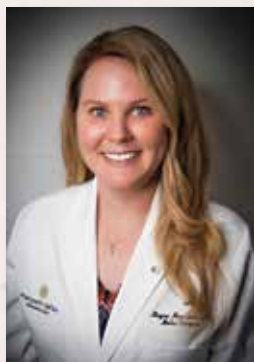

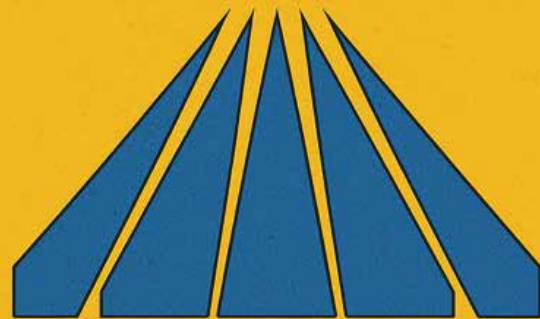

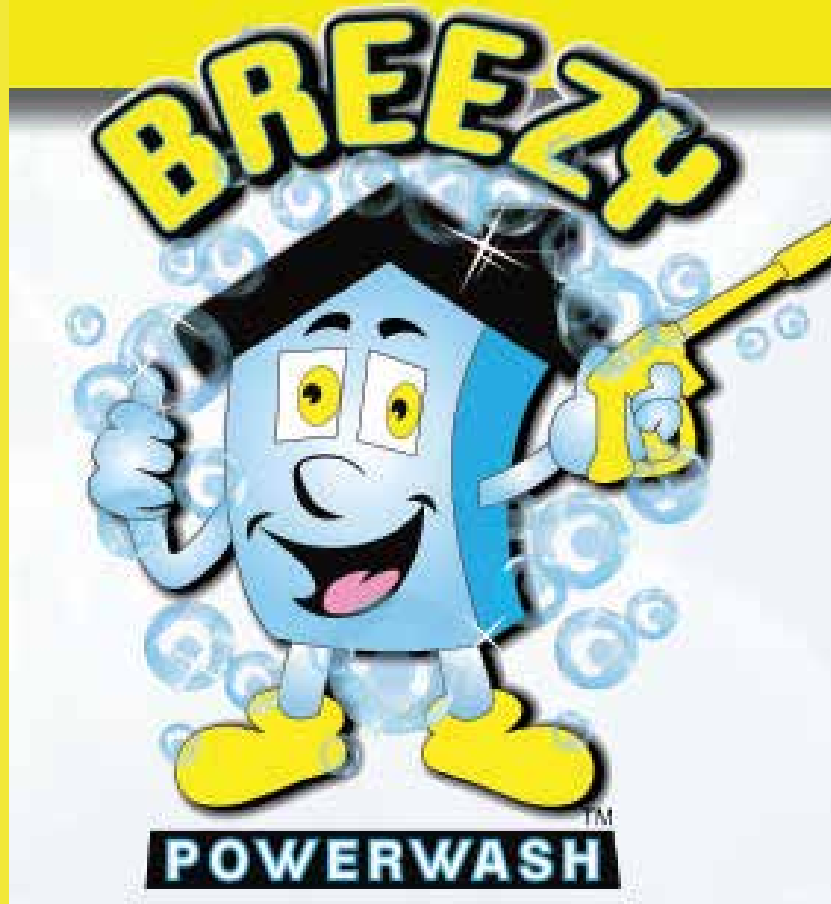

EDUCATIONAL CALLING

JASON ZASKY

Jason Schoenholz has been the new owner of The Tutoring Center location in Berry Farms for just a few months, but he has already settled in nicely, thanks in part to his longstanding experience working with kids.

"I was a full-time minister for 20 years, still preach on a regular basis, and have history interacting with and teaching kids through church," he offers. "When I was preaching in Arkansas, I led the church's afterschool program, taught martial arts classes, and helped kids with their homework."

Schoenholz's management style is also well-suited to the Tutoring Center.

"I tend to be process-oriented; I don't like to beat around the bush. I'm a 'let's get done what we need to get done' type of guy, and let's do things in the best way possible so we achieve the best results," he continues.

Schoenholz says students come to the Tutoring Center for one of three main reasons. First, there are the those who "are struggling or behind in one or more academic areas," he begins. "The second reason students come to us is for help preparing for the ACT or SAT. We also do a lot of tutoring in the upper math's," he continues, referring to Geometry, Algebra II, Trigonometry and Calculus. "We'll often get a student who says, 'I'm not sure I am grasping Trig. or Calc. and they will come to us for a semester,'" or until they get through the class.

Of the students who come to The Tutoring Center to prepare for the ACT, approximately seventy-five percent have already taken the test.

"They will come in with a composite score of 20, 21, 22, 24—something like that—and they say 'I want to score higher,' explains Schoenholz. "Our head instructor, Jonathan, will meet with them and say, 'Let's look at your test and see where you did really well, where you could use some improvement, and let's start there.'"

For those who haven't yet taken the ACT or SAT, the Tutoring Center offers a free practice exam (on Saturdays)—a three-hour test that provides a baseline and an indication of strengths and weaknesses.

As to how the Tutoring Center helps ACT and SAT test-takers, it's a multifaceted approach. Naturally, a big part of it is working on the relevant subject matter, but "part of what we do is talk about strategies," says Schoenholz. "Some of the (ACT and SAT) questions are meant to be difficult to understand or lead you down a path when that path is not right. So, we say, 'If you see a question like this, here's how you need to look at that question.'"

Schoenholz also takes care to emphasize a few of the ways the Tutoring Center is unique.

"The thing I love most is that we have one tutor for every two students," he says with pride. "I don't know of any place in Middle Tennessee that has that small of a ratio. If a parent wants as much access with a tutor as possible, then the Tutoring Center is definitely the place."

Another differentiator is the Tutoring Center's patented Rotational Approach to Learning.

"It means that every so often, the kids will either get up or take

a break from what they are doing. Generally, it's 30 minutes, then a break, then 15 minutes, and then take a break, and then finish. It resets the brain and allows you to 'freshen up' before getting back to work," he explains.

As to how much time lead time is needed for the Tutoring Center to prep a student for the ACT or SAT, Schoenholz says three to four months is close to ideal, though six months is even better.

And while coming to the Tutoring Center can be an investment, Schoenholz says the financial investment is oftentimes recouped later.

"With the ACT and SAT, the biggest way you recover the cost of tutoring is in scholarships. If a student scores a 21 or 22 when they first get to us, and then a 25, 26, 29, or 30, they become a much better candidate for a scholarship. A \$1,700 investment could mean a \$5,000 scholarship," he concludes. "If a student scores 30 or above on the ACT and 1200 or above on the SAT, they get into some significantly sized scholarships."

Use fork to shred roast.

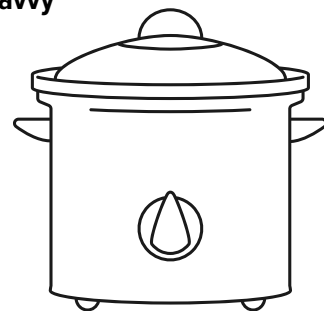
