

# COUNSELING CENTER HAS A BRAND-NEW HOME

Twenty years ago, Refuge Center CEO Amy Alexander and co-founder Jennifer Thames-Hamilton came to the realization that there were few opportunities for affordable counseling in Williamson County. Aiming to offer therapy to individuals, couples, and families who could not afford the fees, they created Refuge Center and began offering counseling services on a sliding-scale fee structure based on income.

In the two decades since, the Center has become the largest counseling center in the region, having provided more than 337,000 sessions since opening its doors in December 2005. The most common "presenting issues" among clients are anxiety,

depression, addiction, and grief & loss, though the Center's 70 counselors and therapists (including 15 full-time staffers) address a wide range of issues that also include pre-marital counseling, marital issues, and divorce adjustment, among others.

"We served more than 4,000 clients last year, and 89 percent of those clients paid between \$25 and \$125 per session," offers Tate Foster, marketing manager for the Refuge Center, noting that upwards of 20 percent of the sessions were provided to kids and teenagers. That's well below the typical cost range for counseling services in Williamson County.

In 2024, the Refuge Center also moved into a \$13 million building on Long Lane, encompassing 15,200 square feet of space.

"We were fundraising and dreaming and planning for over a decade," says Foster, who describes the brand-new building as





"lodge-like, with very Pacific northwest vibes and a lot of wood and stone.... Everything is designed to cultivate healing and inner peace, whether it's before or after a session," he adds. The grounds also feature four acres of walking trails, a healing garden, an outdoor prayer chapel, a playground for children, and a spacious multi-purpose room for seminars and group activities.

#### **Connecting With a Refuge Center Counselor**

Finding a therapist at the Refuge Center is a straightforward process that begins with calling and setting up an intake appointment. This hour-long chat helps the intake specialist understand your goals and match you with the right counselor.

"Our intake specialists will give you a few names, and you can look at those individuals on our website. During the call, they also provide your sliding-scale rate," explains Foster.

There are also other ways to get to know more about the Refuge Center, which offers tours of the facility each Tuesday at 4 pm.

"For donors or community members, the first step to find out more would be one of our Connections lunches, which are held the first and third Thursday of each month at noon," advises Foster, before noting that attendees receive a tour of the building and watch a client story video, while also sharing information about themselves and their work.

Finally, the Refuge Center also sponsors special events that are held off-site, like Live Intentionally 2025, which will take place on February 14, 2025, between 8 am and noon at Church of the City in Franklin.

"It's an event we host every year. This year the topic is on addiction, and will feature speakers on topics like sex addiction, technology & social media, eating disorders, and opiate addiction," concludes Foster, who encourages interested parties to visit the Refuge Center's new home.

"It a unique building, especially for counseling on a sliding-fee scale. There is nothing else like it in the country."



# FINDING THE PERFECT VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

Tom Thousand spent many years helping low-income residents with home repairs. After retirement, he knew he wanted to continue helping people in his free time.

He answered the call to serve through AmeriCorps Seniors RSVP. Since 2010, he has volunteered to deliver meals to those in need, transported donated food to food pantries and captained boats on a nearby lake for group trips. Thousand was there when his neighbors needed rides to medical appointments and the Red Cross needed help delivering blood in his community.

All across the country, AmeriCorps Seniors connects people aged 55 and older with opportunities to volunteer in their communities. The program matches each volunteer's interests and skills with local non-profit organizations. More than 140,000 older Americans serve their communities yearly through three core programs - the RSVP Program, the Foster Grandparent Program and the Senior Companion Program.

Many older adults look for variety, flexibility and benefits when searching for a way to volunteer.

"Since it was established in 1971, our RSVP program has been one of the nation's largest older adult volunteer programs," said Atalaya Sergi, national director, AmeriCorps Seniors. "The program has a wide variety of service opportunities that allow volunteers to help address our nation's most pressing challenges. For our volunteers, RSVP takes the guesswork out of choosing how and where to volunteer their time and energy."

Opportunities vary by city and state, but the RSVP program offers volunteers diverse ways to serve through local organizations. Examples include packaging meals for people with disabilities or other older adults, working in a call center for fraud victims, coordinating poetry workshops at a community center to stimulate the minds of those participating or transporting cancer patients to medical appointments. Service could also involve workforce development and job training or providing disaster preparedness assistance.



There are even select programs specifically designed to support veterans.

Mark Piscatelli volunteers at veterans' coffeehouses. Coordinated through his local AmeriCorps Seniors RSVP program, the coffeehouses allow veterans to gather and socialize with each other and with volunteers. The social setting creates a safe space, fostering community and stability for everyone involved. Guest speakers frequently visit and provide new and updated information to attendees on local and national veterans' services.

"AmeriCorps Seniors has created a wonderful opportunity for me to learn about veterans, veterans' issues, what they've experienced, what they currently experience and what some of their concerns are going forward," Piscatelli said.

David Langlois, a fellow volunteer, concurs.

"I really think that the bottom line is to support our veterans," he said.

Older adults need volunteer programs that fit their lifestyles and allow them to choose how, where and the frequency of their service. Commitments range from a few hours to 40 hours per week. This flexibility allows Piscatelli and his fellow volunteers to participate without feeling overwhelmed by time obligations.

Volunteering is more than a way to fill time, however. Research from sources such as the National Institute on Aging suggests that older adults who are engaged in social and community activities maintain mental and physical health longer than those who are not.

"After one year of service, 88% of our volunteers reported a decrease in feelings of isolation," Sergi said. "Plus, 78% of volunteers felt less depressed. That uplifts spirits and significantly impacts and benefits people's lives."

Yolanda Dave is an example of the positive impact of volunteering on the community and the volunteers themselves. She started volunteering more than 20 years ago because helping her community with hunger, isolation and literacy issues empowered her to be part of the solution. It's more than that, though. She also benefits from the experience.

"I love volunteering," Dave said. "You meet wonderful people of all ages. I get to share my skills, my experience. It keeps me active, mentally and physically, which is very healthy."

Volunteers like Thousand, Piscatelli, Langlois and Dave support people in need and strengthen their communities and neighborhoods. If you're 55 or older and looking for the right volunteer opportunity, visit AmeriCorps.gov/YourMoment to explore opportunities near you.

# **Chocolate Raspberry Torte**

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

**2 CUPS WHITE SUGAR** 

13/4 CUPS ALL-PURPOSE FLOUR

1 CUP UNSWEETENED COCOA POWDER

11/2 TEASPOONS BAKING POWDER

11/2 TEASPOONS BAKING SODA

1/2 TEASPOON SALT

2 LARGE EGGS (ROOM TEMPERATURE)

1 CUP MILK (ROOM TEMPERATURE)

1/2 CUP VEGETABLE OIL

2 TEASPOONS VANILLA EXTRACT

**1 CUP BOILING WATER** 

1/2 CUP RASPBERRY JAM

**2 CUPS FRESH RASPBERRIES** 

#### **FROSTING**

1 CUP OF ROOM TEMPERATURE UNSALTED BUTTER
1/2 CUP COCOA POWDER
5 CUPS OF CONFECTIONARY SUGAR
2 TEASPOON VANILLA EXTRACT
3-4 TABLESPOONS MILK

(if you have raspberry juice you can substitute half milk/half raspberry juice)

#### From the kitchen of Ruth Woetzel

#### **DIRECTIONS TORTE**

Gather all ingredients.

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Grease and flour two 9-inch round baking pans.

Stir sugar, flour, cocoa, baking powder, baking soda, and salt together in a large bowl.

We put all dry ingredients into a sieve, and then all ingredients are well combined.

Add room temperature eggs, milk, oil and vanilla; mix for 2 minutes on medium speed with an electric mixer.

Stir in the boiling water. The batter will be thin. Pour equal parts of the batter into the two prepared pans.

Bake in the preheated oven until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean, about 30 to 35 minutes. Cool in the pans for 10 minutes, then transfer to a wire rack to cool completely.

We put a layer of raspberry jam, chocolate icing, and fresh raspberries between the 2 cakes. Then decorate with chocolate icing and fresh raspberries on top.

#### **DIRECTIONS FROSTING**

1 cup of room temperature unsalted butter

1/2 cup cocoa powder

5 cups of confectionary sugar

2 teaspoon vanilla extract

3-4 tablespoons milk (if you have raspberry juice you can substitute half milk / half raspberry juice)

With a hand mixer, whip the room temperature unsalted butter and cocoa together until smooth. Once all creamed together, add vanilla extract. On low speed, slowly add the


confectionary sugar one spoon at a time. As frosting gets thick, add milk (or raspberry juice)


one tablespoon at a time until the mixture reaches desire consistency. Scrape side and whip until smooth and fluffy.


