

ultimately distribute wealth to the next generation.

EDUCATION TRANSFORMATION FROM INDIA TO WILLIAMSON COUNTY

STUDENT UPS ACT WITH HELP OF LOCAL TUTORS

When Akshat Krishnan came from India to the United States in April 2019, he quickly discovered some important differences between the educational systems in the two countries. A family friend suggested he reach out to The Tutoring Center, on Hughes Crossing in Franklin, to help make the adjustment from going to school in Pune, near Dubai, and attending Ravenwood High School in Brentwood.

One of his main challenges concerned mathematics.


"In India they don't separate algebra, geometry, and pre-calculus," he explains. "They mix everything together and teach students in portions over the years. But here they separate the subjects, so as a freshman, you take Algebra I, and then the next year, it's geometry. Then it's Algebra II and pre-calculus or something else."

Over the course of a year or so, the tutors at The Tutoring Center were able to help him fill in the gaps and catch up in subjects where he was behind.

In the meantime, he also faced the daunting prospect of taking the ACT, so he enrolled in The Tutoring Center's ACT prep program four months before he was scheduled to take the test.

"He took the ACT with us in the beginning, and he scored a 27," relates Joshua Powers, director of The Tutoring Center. But when he took the ACT after completing the Center's four-month

program, he raised his score dramatically.

"He went from a 27 to a 35 composite score. So, he improved eight points, which is massive," offers Powers, noting that "this is a good representation of what kids can do when they are really committed—when they are putting in the effort behind the scenes."

"I got a lot of help from The Tutoring Center," elaborates Krishnan. "I also practiced on my own a little bit, searching for sample papers and working sample problems."

Now the Ravenwood High senior is in a much better position to get into the colleges and universities of his choice, not to mention secure valuable scholarship money.

Krishnan says when all is said and done, he plans to apply to a dozen schools, and he hopes to study accounting when he gets to college.

"He has a couple of acceptances already, and we're working to help him figure out the scholarship situations," adds Powers, who encourages parents to think ahead, whether that concerns getting


their kids ready for standardized tests or securing other academic help.

"Prepping for the ACT is a three- to four-month process. Don't wait until two or three weeks before the exam to give us a call," he advises, as "the rule of thumb is that every month you are with us equals a point. If you're with us for two months, you'll get roughly two points higher. If you're with us for four months, you will see a three- to five-point improvement." Or, in Krishnan's case, eight points.

That can make a big difference when it comes to the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship, for example.

"The majority of students are just out of line for the HOPE scholarship," explains Powers. "Our goal is to get [families] at least \$8,000 in scholarships and \$4,000 in the first year [of college] alone." That far exceeds the cost of ACT test preparation at The Tutoring Center and a decidedly strong return on investment.

To be sure, Krishnan is glad his family friend connected him with The Tutoring Center. The individual attention he got from his tutor was particularly valuable. "I liked it," he says. "It was a positive experience, and everyone was real nice there."






