

Jackson and his team specialize in caring for patients who experience dental anxiety.

permanent, like natural teeth. They allow patients to brush and eat foods such as corn on the cob. They are a wonderful solution that can also help to preserve bone."



Elite Upholstery and Leather Restoration—located on Columbia Avenue in Franklin—has been in business since 1992, so owner Layne Pollak and his colleagues have seen it all when it comes to upholstery, whether that's for auto, home, work, marine, or aviation.

"My father has done restoration work my entire life, so I pretty much picked up from the family business," explains Pollak, before noting that Elite does everything from antique wood restoration to complete auto restorations.

"We restore pretty much anything that is leather or can be upholstered," he says, "including everything from furniture—like a couch or grandma's rocking chair—to ladies handbags."

The business is also well-equipped to handle large commercial jobs. For instance, Elite recently repaired 250 wood doors for a local hospital. Auto dealerships are big clients, too, commissioning everything from paint & bodywork to alloy wheel repair to dashboard repair, mold remediation, and deodorization.

But the bread-and-butter of the business comes from individuals who are auto enthusiasts, or have furniture or other cherished



items they want to restore. For instance, Pollak & Co. see a lot of classic automobiles and rare sports cars.

"I recently restored a 1980 Vespa with a sidecar," notes Pollak, "and right now we are putting a modern air-conditioning unit into a 1957 Chevy truck," a process that is very different from doing a typical auto repair. It's one that requires a mix of experience, creativity, adaptability, and persistence.

"When people go to get things repaired, they are accustomed to a service person giving them a quote for parts and labor, and it's a known quantity," begins Pollak. "In our business, you might be putting on a 'new' part, but 'new' might be that it has been recently restored or rebuilt. And the part it is going onto is itself 60 or 70 years old. So the thing you attached it to needs to be restored, and then the thing after that needs to be restored. Oftentimes you have to customize. For example, we have to make parts for that '57 truck

because in 1957 they didn't have air-conditioning."

As for Pollak's favorite auto restoration projects, he says he really likes to work on Porsche's, having restored numerous 911's, for example. "I get to see a lot of one-of-a-kinds," he adds, "like a 1987 Porsche Carrera that has 3,000 miles on it. There are maybe thirty of those cars in the world, and there is one here in Nashville, and it's got really low miles."

But it's all those years of experience that prompts customers to rely on Elite's broad-based background and creative vision.

"Folks come in and see what we've done and say, 'We trust you, give us an interior that will blow our minds.' We come up with a color scheme and get input from our upholsterers. Then we sketch it out, order the materials and go," relates Pollak.

But many customers also enjoy the fact that Elite has over 300 specialty leather hides in stock. "They are here hanging on our walls, so customers can come in and choose the leather they

want," explains Pollak. "We also have a lot of fabric and a lot of headliner material. It means that our customers can come in and find what they want to put in their car or on a piece of furniture and they don't have to wait. We can do the job the same day, or the day after."

Asked what else separates Elite Leather Restoration from its competitors, Pollak says," We're friendly, and we care. We try to go the extra mile, as people have cherished items they want to take care of. We are maniacal about details—very detail-oriented. And I think we are the only upholstery shop in town that offers free loaner cars to our customers while their car is getting worked on."

Moreover, the coatings that Elite uses are cutting-edge—"really space-age," as Pollak puts it. "We stand behind things with a lifetime warranty. If for some reason something peels or cracks, it's typically a one-off, and we will re-do it at no charge."

All that said, Pollak encourages new customers to either

walk-in or call about potential projects, as he really looks forward to seeing what comes through the door, whether it's a classic car, a piece of luggage that's a hundred years old, or items that have great historical significance.

"The coolest thing I've ever restored is a genuine World War II bomber jacket that survived 35 missions over Nazi Germany," says Pollak. "The family entrusted us with restoring the leather on this bomber jacket and making a shadow box to display it."

In fact, many times, what happens is that customers come in with a piece of furniture—and then bring in a car, or vice-versa. "People come in for work on their car and see what we can do for upholstery in general, and we end up doing a lot of their other work," concludes Pollak.

ARE YOU STILL PLANNING TO RETIRE EARLY?

Have your retirement plans changed because of COVID-19? If so, you have plenty of company. Nearly 40 percent of those planning to retire say the pandemic has disrupted their intentions, according to the Edward Jones/ Age Wave Four Pillars of the New Retirement study. You might have been thinking about retiring early – can you still do so?

Even without a crisis, it's not a bad idea to review your important life goals from time

to time. So, in thinking about the possibility of early retirement, consider these factors:

YOUR RETIREMENT LIFESTYLE

Your ability to retire early depends somewhat on what sort of lifestyle you're anticipating during your retirement years. So, by adjusting these variables – taking Social Security earlier or later, taking more or less money from your retirement accounts – you can help determine if the retirement date you had in mind is viable.

YOUR FEELINGS ABOUT WORK

Your goals are not static – they can change in response to any number of reasons, both external and personal. When you first decided you wanted to retire early, you might have been motivated by, among other things, a weariness of your current job. But has that changed over time? Have you found new challenges that interest you at work? Or, if you were forced by the pandemic to work remotely, did you actually enjoy the arrangement and want to continue it?

After all, many employers have found that their workers can be just as productive working at home, so, even when we've gotten past COVID-19, we might see a sizable shift in the geography of the workplace. In any case, if your feelings about work have changed in some way, leading you to think you could work longer than originally planned, you'd likely gain some financial advantages. You'd make more money, for starters, but you'd also keep building your 401(k) and IRA, and you could even possibly delay taking Social Security.

The pandemic may lead to a reevaluation of many financial goals – and taking early retirement might be one of them. By thinking carefully about your situation and your options, you can come up with a course of action that's right for you.

award, approved and sent from the DAR national headquarters in Washington, DC.

"We are truly honored to receive this award," said Chris DeBerry. "When we founded our agency in 2003, we made it a priority to support our community through our personal involvement and give-back efforts. We are humbled to receive this recognition."

Through the years, the DeBerrys have supported the local community in many ways sponsoring community and school sports teams and supporting teachers and local police and fire departments

The DeBerrys are longtime members of the Spring Hill Chamber of Commerce. Both Eric and Chris have served as chamber board members. In 2006, Chris coordinated the chamber's first business expo, which has continued as an annual event. Eric was recently appointed to serve a second term as a board member.

The DeBerrys founded the Spring Hill Country Ham Festival in 2004. They coordinated the event for many years, forging a grassroots effort to grow the festival into a regional attraction and even working with the Tennessee State Legislature to declare the first Saturday in October the official Country Ham Day in the State of Tennessee.

In 2010, the DeBerrys stepped back from coordinating the festival and turned it over to the title sponsor to continue operations. In 2019, the Spring Hill Country Ham Festival was revitalized and rebranded as The Whole Hog Festival to serve as the main fundraiser for the local food pantry The Well Outreach.

The DeBerrys are big supporters of Snooty Giggles Dog Rescue, located in Thompson's Station, TN. The agency was recently recognized as a national "Change Agent" for their work with Snooty Giggles by Safeco Insurance and won \$2,000 to donate to the rescue.

Each year, the DeBerrys host a Free Shred Day for the commu-

nity. To date, the agency has collected nearly ten tons of paper for recycling through the event, saving hundreds of trees from being used to make paper. The secure shredding service also helps to prevent identity fraud by ensuring identifying papers are securely discarded. Although the 2020 event was canceled, the DeBerrys are already planning for their next Free Shred Day event to be held in April of 2021.


SANTA IN BERRY FARMS




