#### THE LANTERN AT MORNING POINTE

NEW ALZHEIMER'S CENTER OF EXCELLENCE FILLS A GROWING NEED IN MAURY, WILLIAMSON COUNTIES

In 2017 Morning Pointe Senior Living opened a freestanding assisted living community at 1001 McCutcheon Creek Lane in Spring Hill. Last year Morning Pointe added an adjacent 33,000-square-foot memory care community, one which is specifically designed to meet the needs of senior residents with Alzheimer's disease and related conditions.

"The Lantern, our Alzheimer's Center of Excellence, serves residents of all stages of memory care from early onset of dementia to the more advanced stages of Alzheimer's," explains Will Brewer, Vice President of Corporate Communications for Independent

dent Healthcare Properties & Morning Pointe. As such, the two communities complement each other, much like they do at many of the other properties that Morning Pointe operates in Tennessee, Georgia, Alabama, Kentucky, and Indiana.

That is, residents move into the assisted living part of the community, "but as their needs change they might need memory care and then it's an easy transition from assisted living to our memory care building," says Brewer. He notes that Morning Pointe has a similar pair of communities in Franklin, as well as facilities in Brentwood and Columbia.

But whether residents live in one of the 70-plus apartments in the assisted living community at Spring Hill or one of the 44 apartments in the memory care center, everyone enjoys premier amenities and farm-fresh produce and food, not to mention physical and occupational therapy and wellness programming. "We have a lot of engaging programs, and there is a lot of life enrichment going on in the two buildings," adds Brewer.

For The Lantern residents, that includes Morning Pointe's trademarked Meaningful Day program, which focuses on each individual's interests and life experiences, and allows for "personalized" programming, as opposed to a "one size fits all" approach.

Morning Pointe also utilizes the approach favored by leading dementia expert Teepa Snow, who created the Positive Approach to Care model of Alzheimer's and dementia caregiving.

"We also use the Best Friends™ approach, a program that approaches memory care from the standpoint of 'You really want to become best friends with the residents, and once you become a trusted friend they start feeling comfortable, and you get a better response from them," explains Brewer.

At the same time, Morning Pointe also provides ample support for family members of people with dementia and Alzheimer's disease.

For one, The Lantern (Spring Hill) hosts a monthly virtual support group for caregivers of people with dementia and Alzheimer's that features nationally recognized geriatric neuropathologist Dr. David Hutchings, as a regular guest. Dr. Hutchings helps families cope with the challenges they face in caring for a loved one with memory impairment, and being part of a virtual support group helps remind everyone that others are experiencing many of the same challenges and frustrations.

Yet one of the biggest differentiators between Morning Pointe and its competitors are the nurses and staffers, says Brewer. "Peo-

ple help you do a lot of things, and when you have the right people in the right buildings, good things happen."







# Tolerate Hot Days with a Tasty Tart

Summer days can be long and boring, especially when the kids are out of school and there is nothing to do around the house as a family. When the minutes creep by and it's too hot to go outside, the dog days of summer can be pretty miserable.

However, this recipe for a Strawberry Cream Cheese

Tart can give the kids something to look forward to as a dish the whole family can participate in creating.

This recipe is perfect for little ones wanting to get creative and perfectly place fresh strawberries on top of a delicious tart.

#### INGREDIENTS CRUST:

11/4 CUPS FLOUR

1/4 CUP GRANULATED SUGAR

1/4 TEASPOON SALT

1/2 CUP COLD BUTTER, CUT INTO SMALL CUBES

1 LARGE EGG

1/2 TEASPOON VANILLA EXTRACT

**UNCOOKED RICE** 

#### **FILLING:**

- 8 OUNCES REDUCED-FAT CREAM CHEESE
- 1/4 CUP SOUR CREAM
- 2 TABLESPOONS EXTRA-FINE SUGAR
- 1 TABLESPOON LEMON ZEST
- 1/2 TEASPOON VANILLA EXTRACT
- 1/2 CUP STRAWBERRY FRUIT SPREAD
- 3 TEASPOONS LEMON JUICE (OPTIONAL)
- 1 POUND STRAWBERRIES, HALVED WHIPPED CREAM (OPTIONAL)

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Heat oven to 375 F.
- To make crust: In food processor, add flour, sugar and salt; pulse until combined. Add butter, egg and vanilla extract; pulse until combined and crumbly.
- Lightly flour surface then form dough into ball. Slightly flatten to form thick disc. Wrap dough in plastic wrap; refrigerate 1 hour.
- Flour surface then roll dough to 11-inch circle. Place dough in 9-inch tart pan with removeable bottom. With rolling pin, roll over top to trim excess dough around edges.
- Cover dough with plastic wrap and freeze until firm, about 30 minutes.

- Press aluminum foil against crust, covering edges to prevent burning.
   Fill and distribute uncooked rice evenly. Bake 20 minutes.
   Cool completely.
- To make filling: In medium bowl, beat cream cheese, sour cream, sugar, lemon zest and vanilla extract until blended and smooth. Spread cheese mixture evenly over crust. Refrigerate 1 hour.
- In small bowl, microwave fruit spread and lemon juice, if desired, stirring often.
- Arrange strawberry halves around tart. Drizzle heated fruit spread over strawberries. Top with whipped cream, if desired.

# SPRING HILL TAPS BATTLE OF FRANKLIN TRUST TO MANAGE RIPPAVILLA

The Battle of Franklin Trust has been selected by the City of Spring Hill to operate and manage Rippavilla, a pre-Civil War home with 98 adjoining acres. Rippavilla and Spring Hill are just minutes from historic Franklin, where the Trust also manages two historic sites - Carnton and Carter House.


In making the announcement, Battle of Franklin Trust CEO Eric A. Jacobson said, "Rippavilla played a key role in the Battle of Spring Hill on November 29, 1864, which led to the Battle of Franklin the following day. We welcome the opportunity to tell Rippavilla's story and interpret the lives of the Cheairs family. In addition, the story of slavery and the enslaved at Rippavilla is profoundly impactful and will help guests better understand the path toward civil war."

Rippavilla is owned and has been supported by the City of Spring Hill since 2017. It was opened to the public in the mid-1990s.

Jacobson added, "Rippavilla presents many opportunities to preserve and interpret the history of the area both before, during, and after the Civil War. Our mission at the Battle of Franklin Trust is to teach how the war redefined America and how we have all been impacted by it and its results."

The Battle of Franklin Trust will reopen Rippavilla to the public on May 24 for guided tours as well as specialty tours. The site will be open seven days a week. Ticket prices will be \$18 for a Classic House Tour and \$25 for all specialty tours, which will include Battlefield, Slavery, and Extended Tours.
