



ALL THINGS ELVIS

Franklin resident, Stephen Shutts was very young when he first discovered Elvis.

"I was mesmerized as a young kid and I begged my dad to take me to see him in concert," he recalls. "So, my dad became a fan, and we went to four Elvis concerts in Ohio where I grew up. Then I went to college near Memphis because of the history and that sort of thing."

As he learned more about Elvis, his interest became a passion that evolved into a lifelong business. Shutts became a collector of all things Elvis and began buying, selling, and curating items once owned by the King.

"Things like jumpsuits, jewelry, and other clothing," Shutts

says. "I've had a TV he shot out, I've had several of his vehicles. I have one of his snowmobiles sitting in my living room right now. Elvis gave it to a detective in Denver after a snowmobiling trip. I had a ski boat I found in a barn in Arkansas that's currently on display in Graceland."

He also began collecting Elvis' autographs and became an expert on authenticating Elvis' handwriting.

"Elvis never turned anyone away, so he signed thousands upon thousands of autographs. But there are also a lot of forgeries out there. And because he got immense amounts of mail and couldn't sit down and sign everything, his secretaries would also often sign for him."

Shutts has written a book that delves deeper into Elvis au-



tographs in several ways. The book "Yours Elvis Presley" offers guidance in authenticating an Elvis signature, while also sharing personal accounts of people who got his autograph in person.

"The book is all about the encounters and the autographs obtained by people, and the stories they recall having met him. Then there's a study guide, a separate booklet that goes along with it, that breaks down how to analyze Elvis' autograph if you want to collect or study his handwriting."

Nearly 50 years after his death, an Elvis autograph remains extremely valuable. Depending on the type and circumstances surrounding it, one can sell for anywhere between \$1500 and \$30,000.

Shutts, who never got to meet Elvis personally, says he's amazed by what he hears from those who did. Those experiences remain vivid even decades later.

"I've met so many people who were gate gals, people who hung out at the gates, or people who got to meet him backstage, and I wanted to document these stories in the book. Women can remember what he smelled like, what he wore, just everything. And guys recall a lot of things, too, because they thought he was cool."

While Shutts spends a lot of time working with Elvis Memorabilia (he has a pop-up shop offering items for sale on his Rockol-

ogy Facebook page every weekend), his expertise stretches into other areas, as well.

"I also deal in a lot of historic country," he explains. "Patsy Cline, Johnny Cash, Hank Williams, and then a lot of contemporary country as far as personal items and stage clothing. I handled the Charlie Daniels estate recently as far as partial liquidation, Jerry Lee Lewis and B.J Thomas, so I do a lot of celebrity estates and collections."

He also had a show for several years on CMT that dealt with the search for memorabilia.

He enjoys it all, but there's something special about Elvis. "I think because of his undeniable, incredible looks and charisma, he was clearly in his own class."

It's a fascination he shares with many around the world, including those he highlights in the book who actually met him.

"It's like his presence is still here today when you talk to these people," Shutts says. "When people recall having met him, it's never sloughed off; it's like 'I met Elvis, let me tell you about him.' Sadly, it's a dwindling class of people just because of age, but they all have a common thread of adoration and are fascinated with having met him. And a lot of times, he changed their lives in a lot of different ways."



BERRY, BERRY CLEAN

In an industry increasingly defined by private equity firms and dominated by publicly traded companies, Franklin's newest car wash stands apart.

"Being that we are family-owned and operated, our car wash has a different feel. There is a lot more care and thought put into customers and the final product," begins Jennifer Carroll, who coowns Pure Clean Car Wash with her husband, Brian.

Located at 4209 Long Lane, less than a mile from Franklin's Berry Farms community and very near Williamson County Ag Expo Park, Pure Clean Car Wash even looks different than most other car washes.

"The physical property and the building are beautiful," elaborates Carroll, a sharp contrast to the cinderblock-type structures that dominate much of the industry. "We worked hand-in-hand

with the architect on the design," she continues, part of an effort to develop a look & feel that would be a good fit with Berry Farms, not to mention the rest of Franklin and Williamson County.

But it isn't just the aesthetics that set Pure Clean Car Wash apart.

"We are also very environmentally friendly and have a sophisticated water reclaim system," adds Carroll. It's a system that allows Pure Clean Car Wash to recycle almost all the water from every wash and to reuse 70 percent of that water, all of which helps keep chemicals out of the stormwater system. Pure Clean Car Wash also uses LED lighting and motion-activated light switches, which lower the facility's carbon footprint.

"We don't use hydraulic motors, either, which further saves on energy because we aren't using oil," continues Carroll.

Also noticeably absent are the metal guide rails found at most other car washes.

"We have a dual belt conveyor where you are literally loading onto a flat belt," she says, so there is no risk of a metal guide rail potentially damaging tires or rims.

"It's a new development in the car wash industry in terms of equipment," she relates, which means that Pure Clean Car Wash can accommodate wide tires and low-profile vehicles.

As one might expect, Pure Clean Car Wash also uses a license plate recognition system, so customers don't even have to roll down a window when utilizing the available self-serve payment tools. All four monthly subscription options (Pure Basic, Pure Sparkle, Pure Brilliance, and Pure Titanium) offer unlimited washes.

"You pay one price and can wash as many times as you want during the month. If you wash two times per month, you're winning, basically," explains Carroll, before noting that a Family Plan discount is also available, with each additional membership on the same credit card receiving a 25% discount.

Not surprisingly, Pure Clean Car Wash also offers the kind of post-wash amenities not always found elsewhere, including high-pressure vacuums, with window & dash cleaner and microfiber towels available at each individual vacuum station.

Last but not least, Carroll says customer service is yet another area where Pure Clean Car Wash differentiates itself from competitors.

"As consumers, we felt that the car wash segment was missing customer service," offers Carroll, before noting that she and her husband developed and operated their first Pure Clean War Wash in Columbia before selling it and building out the Franklin location.

"We train our employees on the Chick-fil-A® (customer service) model, and we talk about Chick-fil-A all the time," she says, referring to the fast-food restaurant chain's famous and well-respected approach to customer service. "We feel it's an important part of our business that sets us apart (in the car wash industry)," she concludes.

Indeed, Pure Clean Car Wash's approach is working so well that the couple is currently looking to open several more locations, even as the four-month-old Franklin location is still getting integrated into the Berry Farms community—working with area charities and participating in fundraisers with local schools.

"For sure, we are looking forward to building more car washes," concludes Carroll.



JACK ELDER RECEIVES THE 2024 PAT SUMMITT LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

"Sports have always been an important part of my life. I knew at an early age I wanted to be a teacher and coach," begins Jack Elder, recipient of the 2024 Pat Summitt Lifetime Achievement Award, named for the legendary University of Tennessee women's basketball coach and conferred by the Tennessee Sports Hall of Fame. After beginning a teaching and coaching career in south Texas, the El Paso native moved to Nashville in 1972, where he pursued a graduate degree in Physical Education and Recreation for the Handicapped at George Peabody College.

It was there that he was introduced to Special Olympics, which had been founded four years earlier to provide sports training and athletic competition for individuals with intellectual disabilities. In 1973, he was named the first executive director of Tennessee Special Olympics, part of an effort to develop statewide Special Olympics programs all over the country.

"When I first heard about the program, it really got to my heart," says Elder. "I had taken sports for granted, and here we had a whole population that didn't have the opportunity to participate. As soon as Eunice Kennedy Shriver founded Special Olympics, I felt strongly that I wanted to be part of it."

Long story short: by the time Elder moved on to a position with the organization's international office in the late 1980s, Tennessee Special Olympics was recognized as one the country's strongest and best-managed state programs, with upwards of 13,000 athletes participating in local, regional, and statewide competitions in 14 sports.

To get to that place, Elder spent a lot of time on the road introducing the program and explaining it to people.

"In the early years, I sensed that some individuals did not feel that Special Olympians should be considered athletes, but after learning more and/or experiencing the joy, skill, sharing, and courage of the Special Olympics athletes, that perception grew

much smaller," he says. "I focused on visiting colleges & universities, parks & recreation departments, and people with an interest in sports. I also talked to civic groups to educate them and get people to volunteer," he adds, noting that by the time he moved on to a position with Special Olympics International, there were upwards of 8,000 volunteers in Tennessee, working across 16 area programs that covered every county in the state.

That said, this is not the first time that Elder has been honored for his work with Special Olympics. For example, in 1984, he was named Sportsman of the Year by the Nashville Banner.

But on this occasion, he was feted at the Tennessee Sports Hall of Fame banquet, held at the Omni Hotel in downtown Nashville in July. On that day, he shared the spotlight with other athletes, coaches, sportswriters, and sports administrators who have impacted the history of Tennessee sports, with 2024 inductees that included former Tennessee Titans All-Pro running back Chris Johnson; former Nashville Predators goaltender Pekka Rinne; and gold medal-winning figure skater Scott Hamilton, the latter of whom is also famous for his work as a television analyst and commentator.

In addition to being formally honored at the 2024 banquet, Elder had the opportunity to do a live Q&A with Tennessee Titans radio play-by-play announcer Mike Keith. That was a chance to publicly reflect and comment on a career that included operating a regional office (out of Nashville) for Special Olympics International beginning in 1988.

"My role was to work with ten states and two U.S. territories, to help establish Special Olympics programs in other countries,

and to accept other special projects as assigned by Mrs. Shriver," recalls Elder, who is now retired and lives in Spring Hill, where he serves as Vice Chair of the Historic Commission.

Given the opportunity to reflect further, Elder says: "My time with Tennessee Special Olympics was special. It brought me such joy in helping to bring sports participation to a population of individuals that would not, for the most part, have had that experience without Special Olympics. I never made much money, but I don't know how anyone could have had a more rewarding career," he offers.

Elder is also very appreciative of the countless men & women who helped him grow the Tennessee Special Olympics program—without whom his lifetime achievement award wouldn't have been possible.

"I always had a very small but dedicated staff, who were so important in overcoming challenges and reaching milestones. And the athletes, parents, and volunteers—not to mention our Board of Directors and many generous financial contributors—were remarkable to work with and served as an inspiration," he adds, before noting that Music City might well be in the Special Olympics spotlight at the beginning of the next decade, as Nashville and Cleveland are the two finalist cities bidding to host the 2030 Special Olympics USA Games.

As for the Pat Summitt Lifetime Achievement Award: "It means a lot to me," he concludes. "When you're in sports, that's about as good as it gets."




Heat oven to 350 F. Grease Bundt pan.


