August 2021 Sermon Series: Soul Food



Bread is a basic staple food, filling and made of simple ingredients, yet delicious and satisfying. Generally, it is plentiful and readily available. In calling himself the Bread of Life, Jesus speaks to his identification with the needs and interests of the everyday person. It is also a profoundly incarnational and sacrificial theme: Jesus invites us to consume him, to eat and drink of his life. But Jesus does not originate that imagery. In the Hebrew scriptures, we find an invitation to eat and drink from the table of Holy wisdom. This consumption is more than metaphorical. It means internalizing the ways, the thoughts, the imaginations, and the disciplines of the righteous life. This series explores the idea of how our own lives are transformed from the invitation to partake of life-giving realities.

The key scripture passages as shown below lift up important teachings that can deepen our understanding of how life in God feeds our souls.

August 1 – Eat to Live (Communion will be served)

John 6:35; 41-51

August 8 – An Appetite for Righteousness

Matthew 5:1-10; Psalms 34:9-14

August 15 – Hard to Swallow

John 6:56-69

August 22 – Dirty Hands and Clean Hearts

Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

August 29 – Summerfest Worship on Thornapple Plaza

Worship 9:30 am to 11:00 am followed by Cookout


