Greetings to all the members and friends of Green Street Church in the name of Jesus Christ!

Ash Wednesday is March 2, 2022!

We will begin the Lenten season with a collaborative Ash Wednesday service at 7:00 p.m., March 2, 2022 at Hope UMC. I hope you will join us! Our worship team will be providing the music for this service.

Ash Wednesday services always remind me of the words of committal which say, "This body we commit to the ground, earth to earth, ashes to ashes, dust to dust." God spoke similar words to Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden, reminding them and us, that absent an act of God, humans are merely mortal creatures; a worthless pile of ashes and dust. Ashes are rubbish to be discarded and are generally to be avoided in this world. So why do gather and smear ashes on our foreheads during the Ash Wednesday service? Why would we want to remind ourselves of the cold hard truth of our mortality?

The answer is that while we gather to remember who we are as humans, we also gather to remember who God is, and what God has done for us in and through Jesus Christ. We gather because there was in fact a mighty act of God that makes us so much more than mere ashes. God has given us a way out of our plight of "ashes to ashes, dust to dust". It is the way of the Cross. The death of Jesus was God's way of placing a sign of infinite value upon that which would otherwise be worthless. And all that God asks of us in this is that we accept his mercy, that we remember we are sinners, and repent and believe in his Son. And as we accept God's forgiveness, we are likewise instructed to forgive others and to help reconcile others to God.

"In Christ, God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us. So we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us, we entreat you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God." 2 Cor. 5:19-21
