River Valley and will hopefully be officially recognized as the Massachusetts State "Sedimentary



They formed in a flood! The rare Jurassic armored mud balls formed as floods eroded mud banks and rolled hard mud downstream. The mud balls became rimmed (armored) with pebbles and then quickly buried before these delicate features dried and fell apart. Next they were deeply buried, turned to stone, and eventually, luckily, 200 million years later, a rock quarry happened to remove them so they could be found.








There was an old man who lived on a fan. He found AMBs all across his land. Many he collected, but some he rejected: too bland.


