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Jurassic Armored Mud Balls are real!



These rare ancient geologic "sedimentary structures," only easily seen in Massachusetts' Conn. River Valley should be **officially recognized as our State Sedimentary Structure**. They are in the same rock layers as Podokesaurus, our State Dinosaur. The State Geologist and many others, confirm "rarity" and "worthy of official recognition"! The JAMBs formed as floods rolled hard mud downstream. The balls became rimmed (armored) with pebbles, then quickly buried before they dried and fell apart. Then deeply buried, turned to stone, and luckily, 200 million years later, excavated in a rock quarry so they could be discovered. We are EXTREMELY LUCKY to have these RARE SEDIMENTARY STRUCTURES!
