Please Spay/Neuter

SPAY/NEUTER STATISTICS FOR 2025

We started the non-profit in January 2024 and began coordinating spay/neuter services in March. Last year 111 family pets received free surgeries. So far this year 55 animals have completed their surgeries! A huge thank you to Nashville Road Animal Hospital for partnering with us on this effort. And a bigger thank you to those who are donating funds to us to allow us to cover the cost of these procedures.

Spayed or neutered animals tend to live longer than their non-spayed or neutered peers. A study out of the University of Georgia found that out of 70,000 animals, neutered male dogs lived 13.8% longer and spayed female dogs lived 26.3% longer than non-altered animals. The average age of non-neutered dogs was 7.9 years, while neutered dogs live on average to be about 9.4 years.

Be sure you are helping to control the pet population be being a responsible pet owner and having your animals fixed.
