Virtual Pet Halloween Costume Contest

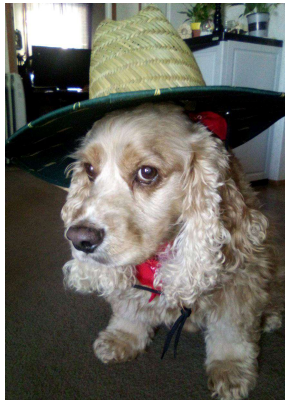

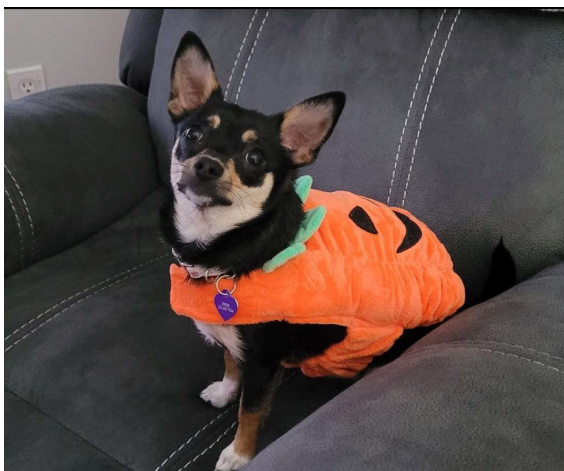

PET FOOD PANTRY DISTRIBUTES FOOD TO MORE THAN 2,300 ANIMALS

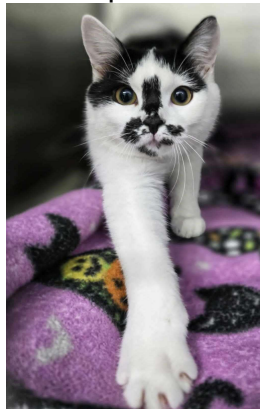
Our first Pet Food Distribution Day was held February 27, 2024. As of October 31, we have fed more than 2,300 animals.
