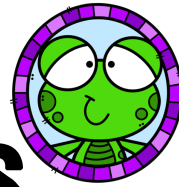

The Froggy Friends showed much growth in their iReady diagnostic. They all took their time and showed their best effort. I will be sharing your child's growth, shortly.



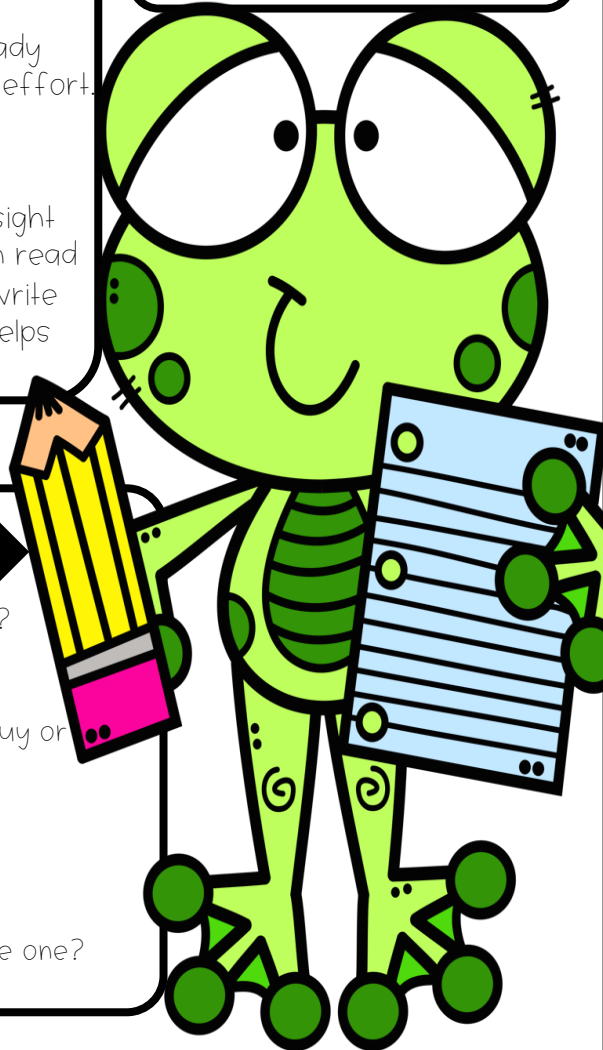

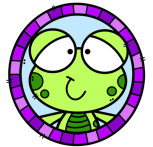
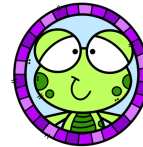
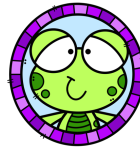
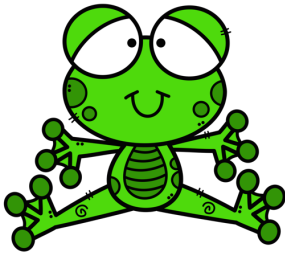
- Tell me about career day? Whose parents were speakers?

Math Workshop

Olders: In topic 9, students use their understanding of place value to plot, order, and compare 2-digit numbers. The students will strengthen their understanding of the place-value system which prepares them for 2-digit addition and subtraction.

Youngers: Topic 9 continues the counting sequence with a focus on numbers 11-20. It highlights the principles necessary for accurate counting as well as a variety of representations including numeral writing and composing and decomposing teen numbers as ten ones and some more ones.

Reading Workshop

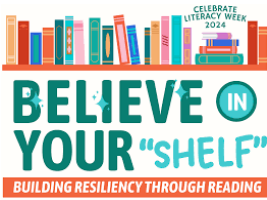
Last week, we read an informational piece titled, Robots at Work. We learned how robots help make life easier for hospitals, farmers and restaurants. Ask your child what the robots do. Throughout the week, we worked on:

- Identifying the main topic and relevant details.
- Using the relevant details to make inferences.
- Explain similarities and differences between information provided in visuals and words.
