

OLDERS and YOUNGERS: Next week, we will be taking a Topic 1-11 cumulative assessment. This will review all concepts taught this school year. I am constantly reviewing past concepts during our math time. It is important that past concepts are not forgotten as math concepts are built on one another.

OLDERS & YOUNGERS NEED TO KNOW:

- Facts to 10 with automaticity & fluency
- Doubles
- Vocab: sum, difference, addend, equal
- Count backwards & forward on a 100 chart when starting at any given number
- Solve story problems by explaining what is being asked and how they will solve it.

Reading Workshop

This week, we will be ending unit 6 and beginning unit 7. The Olders are so excited because in unit 7, the assessments don't read it to them, but rather they read it themselves. Oh, I wish I was a first grader, again!!!

We read "Tall & Small Play Ball" and worked on the following skills:

- Making text-to-text & text-to-self connections.
- Summarizing and inferring.

PHONICS:

OLDERS: Plural nouns that end in —es. Did you know that if a word ends in —ch, —ss, —sh, —x, —z, you add an —es to make it plural.

YOUNGERS: Initial /w/ in short vowel words at the beginning and part of a blend (twin).
