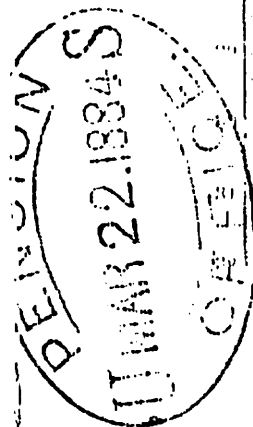


State of Minnesota  
 County of Goodhue ss.  
 On this 17<sup>th</sup> day of March  
 A.D. 1884. personally appeared before me  
 Albert J. Johnson <sup>Deputy</sup> Clerk of the District  
 Court in and for said County, a clerk  
 of record within and for the County  
 and state aforesaid, Archibald  
 Rose aged fifty years a resident of  
 the Town of Half Creek in the County  
 of Goodhue and State of Minnesota  
 who being duly sworn according to  
 law declares that he is the identical  
 Archibald Rose who was enrolled on  
 the first day of September A.D. 1864. as a  
 private in Company C. of the Third (3<sup>d</sup>)  
 Regiment of Minnesota Volunteers  
 Commanded by Captain James M.  
 Morans and was honorably dischar-  
 ged at Jacksonport. Arkansas. on  
 the twenty eighth day of July A.D.  
 1865. by reason of telegram dated  
 War Dept. A. G. O. May. 29<sup>th</sup> 1865. to Maj.  
 J. J. Reynolds. Comd'g Dept of Ark. that  
 his personal description is as follows  
 age, 29 years. height five (5) feet seven (7)  
 inches complexion fair. blue eyes and  
 dark hair. That while a member of  
 the organization aforesaid in the ser-  
 vice and in the line of his duty at  
 Durall's Bluff in the State of Arkansas  
 on or about the fifteenth day of February



AD 1865, I was taken to the Regimental Hospital at Duralls Bluff Arkansas for rheumatism and scurvy and remained in said Hospital until the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March AD 1865. after which time owing to my sickness I was cooking for the officers of the regiment and remained as such until I was discharged and was wholly unable to do service in in my line of duty as a private, owing to the sickness aforesaid and that since my discharge I have been suffering with rheumatism to such an extent as to unable to do hard manual labor. That since my discharge I have been treated by Dr C. H. & N. E. Higbee and Dr W. W. Sweeney, now deceased. That he was treated in the Hospital at Duralls Bluff Arkansas, as before stated. That he has not been employed in the military or naval service other wise than stated above.

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the town of Hay Creek, in the County of Goodhue and State of Minnesota and his occupation has been that of a farmer.

That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good sound physical health, being when enrolled a farmer, That he is now

partially disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries and sickness above described incurred in the service of the United States and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension-roll of the United States.

He hereby appoints M. McCarthy Adjutant General of Minnesota or his Successor in office of Saint Paul State of Minnesota his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim. That he has never received nor heretofore applied for a pension.

That his Post Office address is Rowing County of Goodhue and State of Minnesota

Also personally appeared Herman Schief residing at Rowing Minnesota and Lyman D. Phillips residing at Rowing Minnesota, persons whom I certify to be respectable and entitled to credit and who being by me duly sworn say they were present and saw Archibald Rose the claimant sign his name to the foregoing declaration, that they have every reason to believe, from the appearance of said claimant and their acquaintance with him that he is the identical person

he represents himself to be, and that they have no interest in the prosecution of this claim.
