That these affiants were neighbors of said Rose in the said town of Hay Creek, before he enlisted in the service, and each of them knows that said Rose was a hard working man, free from rheumatism and that since said Rose came home from the service he has been greatly suffering from rheumatism contracted as deponents believe while in the army. and that said Rose has been and now is on account of said rheumatism, unable to do manual labor that deponents know that said Rose, after coming home from the army was treated for the rheumatism by Drs Hawley & Sweeney of Red Wing Minnesota, both of whom are now dead.

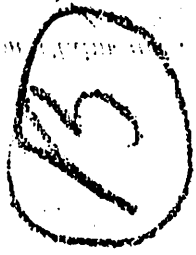
