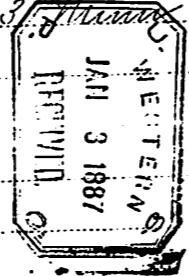

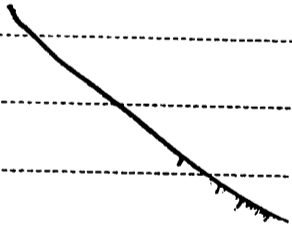
Respectfully returned to the Commissioner of Pensions.

Archibald Rose, a private of Company B, 3rd Regiment Minn. Infy Volunteers, was enrolled on the day of _____, 1864, at _____, and is reported.

He was received at Minn. Infy Rendezvous Sept. 3, 1864, and deserted Sept. 25/64. His charge of desertion is removed under the provisions of the Act of Congress approved July 5, 1884.

He was absent without proper authority from Sept 25/64, to Jan'y, 29/65 - when he was sent to his Regiment, and delivered to Lt. Col. Samuel

D. Karablin, Co. 2d, Officer forwarding recruits Cairo Ills. Feb'y, 14/65.
